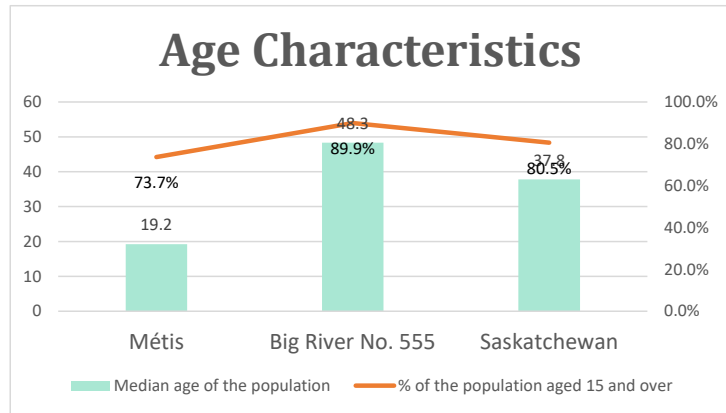


# Big River No. 555, SK

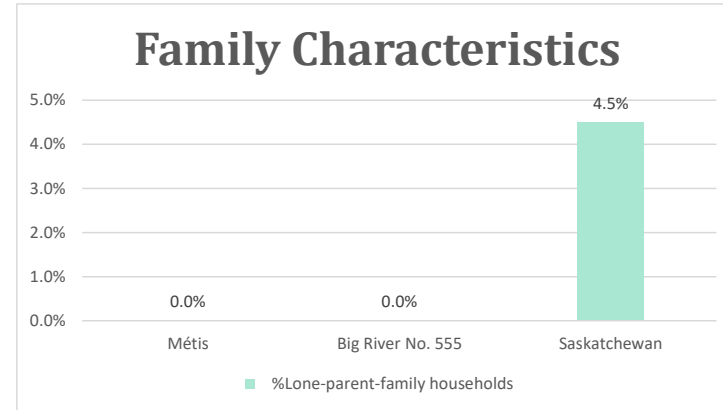

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 95 (Total Métis household is 35), representing 100% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 11.9% of the total population in Big River No. 555.

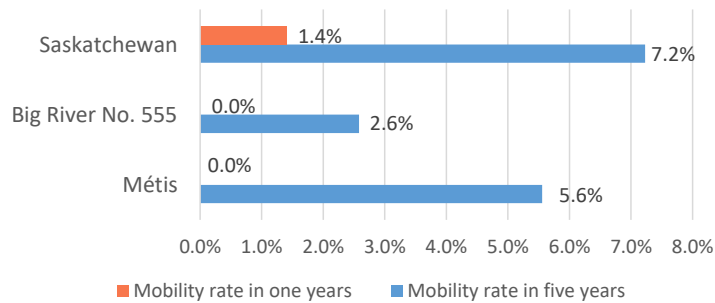


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 19.2 years old, with 73.7% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 48.3 in Big River No. 555 and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 89.9% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



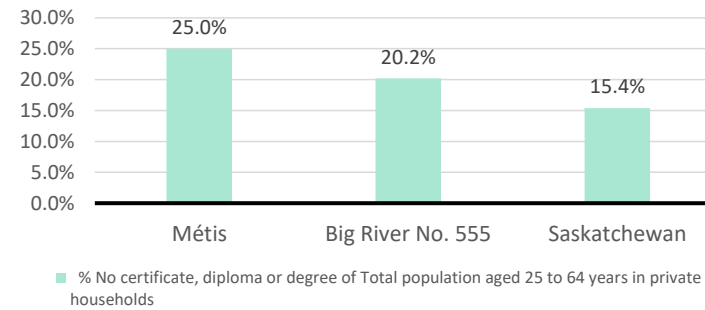
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

## Education



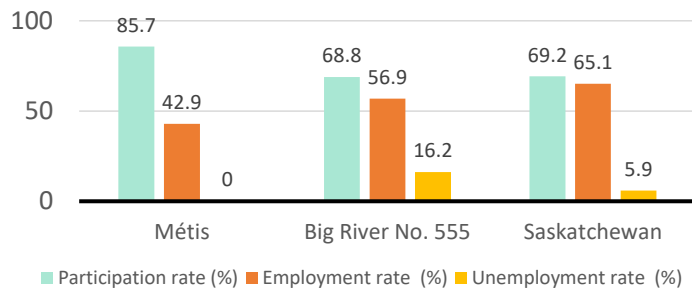

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

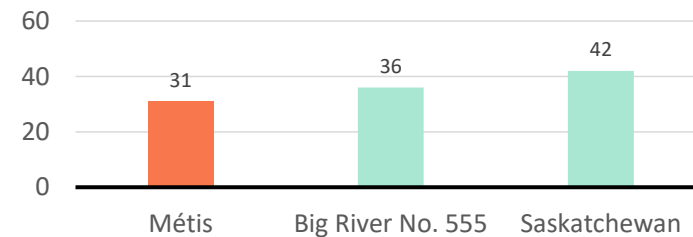
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 85.7%, employment rate is 42.9%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

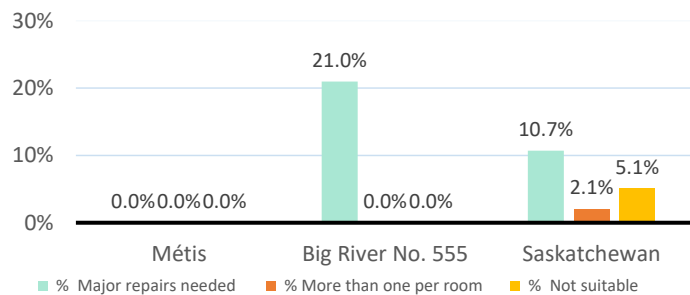
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Big River No. 555 and Saskatchewan (68.8% and 69.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



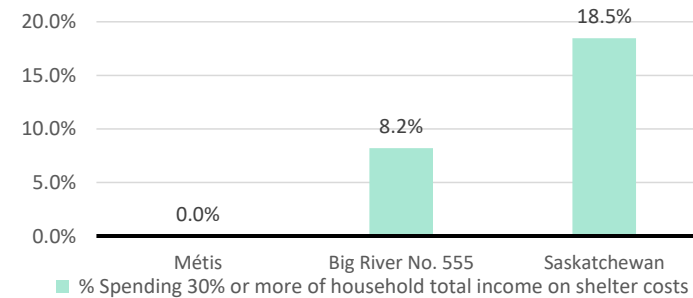
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 31.0 weeks.

### Shelter Costs



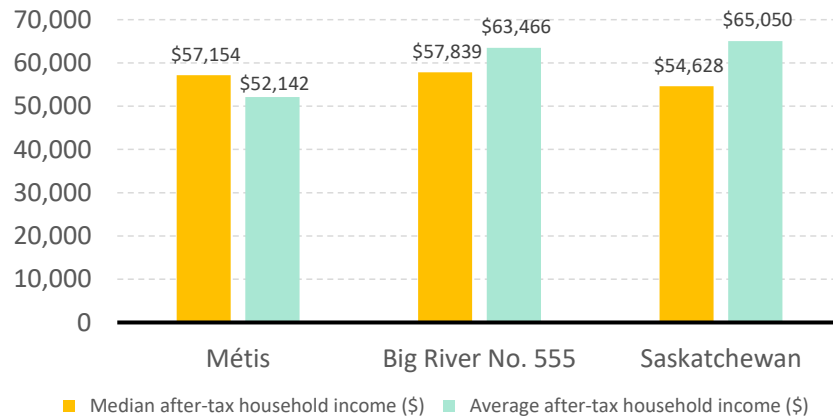
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

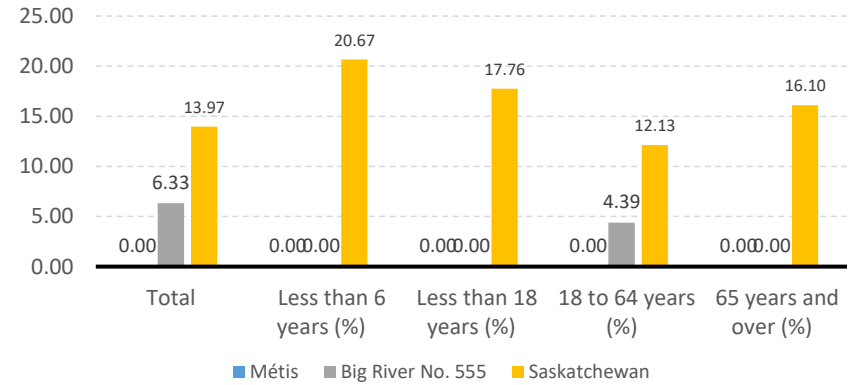
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010
