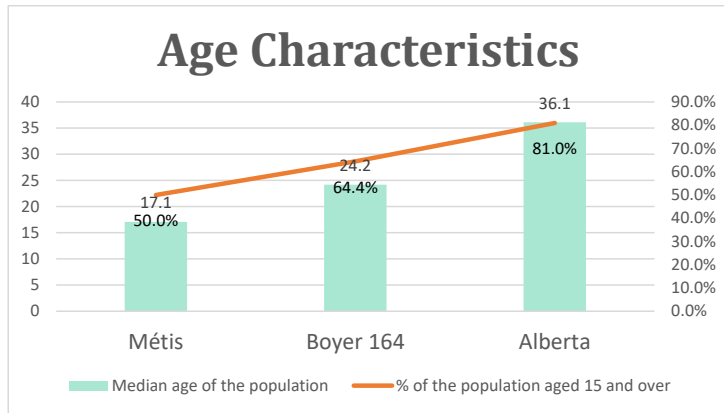

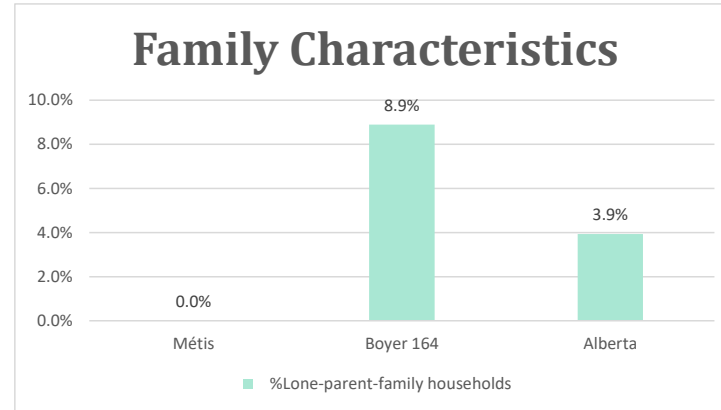

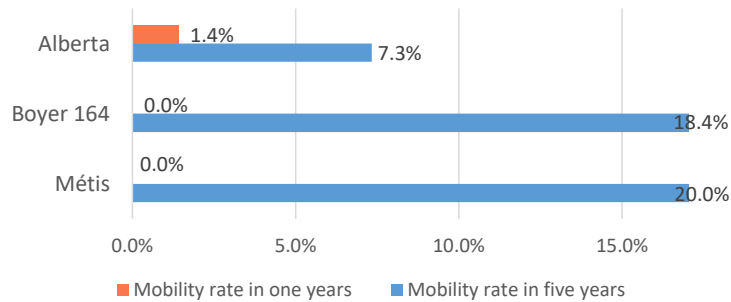

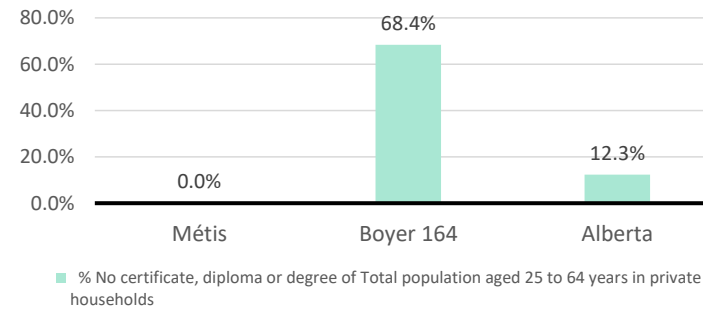

Education



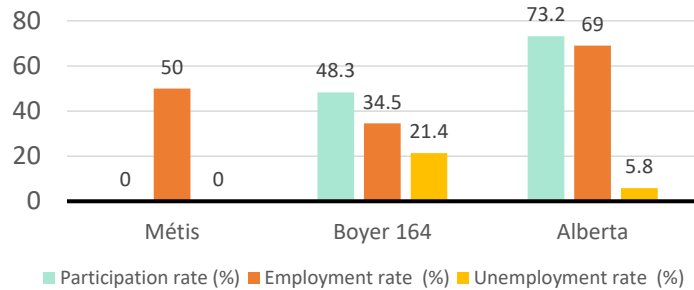

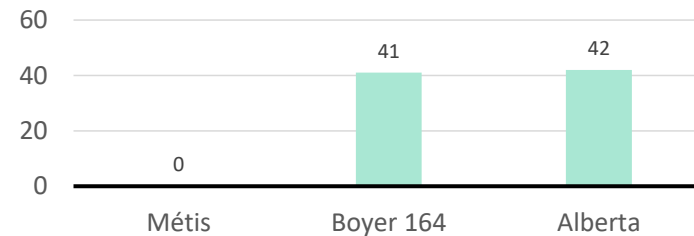

Labour Force Status



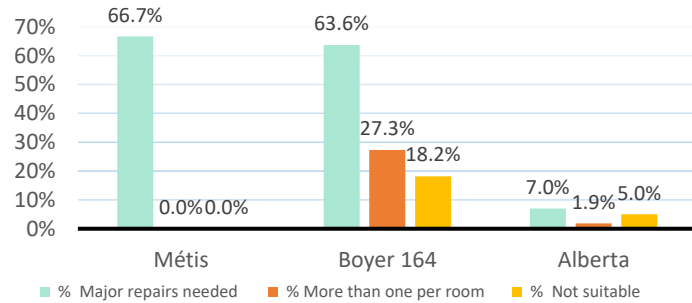

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



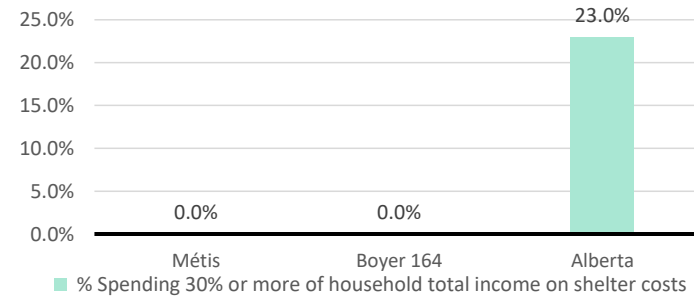

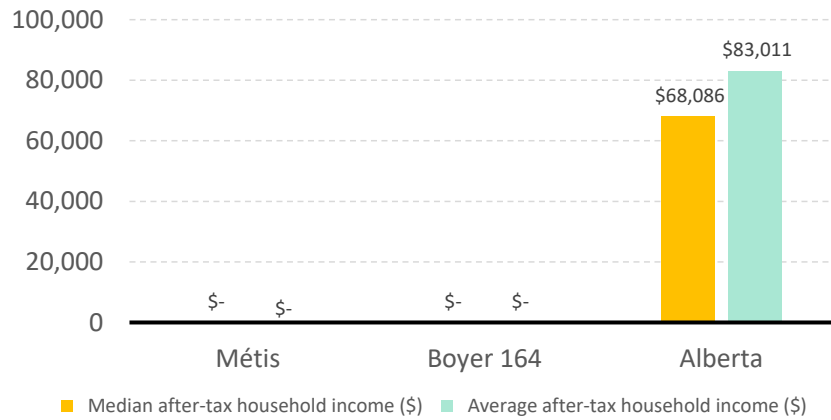

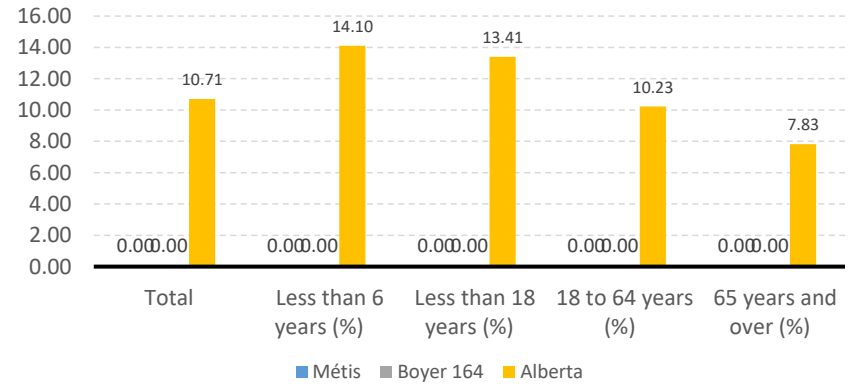
Income
