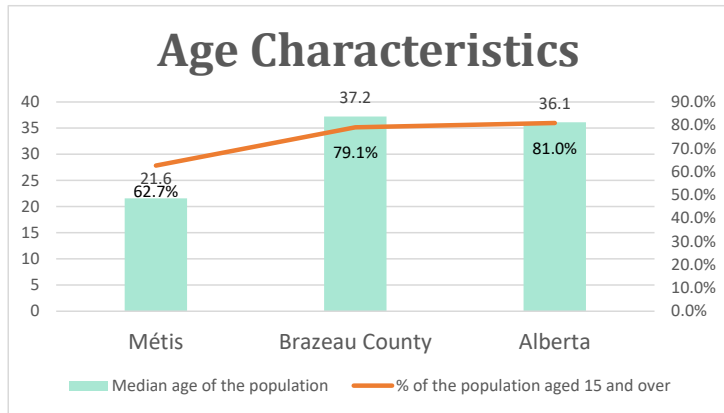

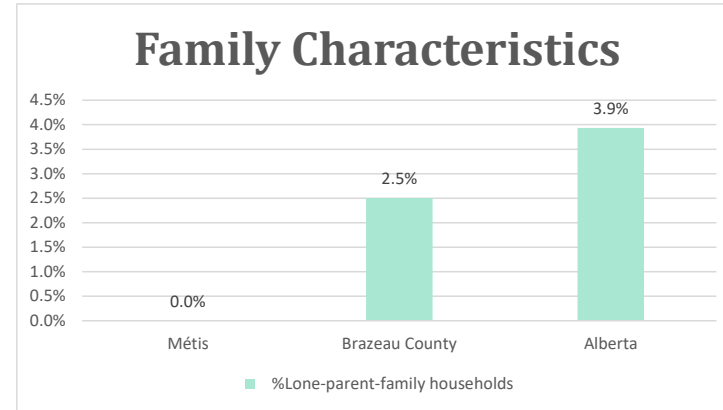

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 415 (Total Métis household is 205), representing 73% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 5.8% of the total population in Brazeau County.

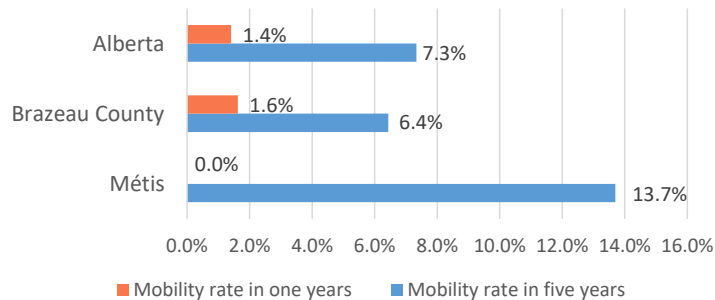


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 21.6 years old, with 62.7% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 37.2 in Brazeau County and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 79.1% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



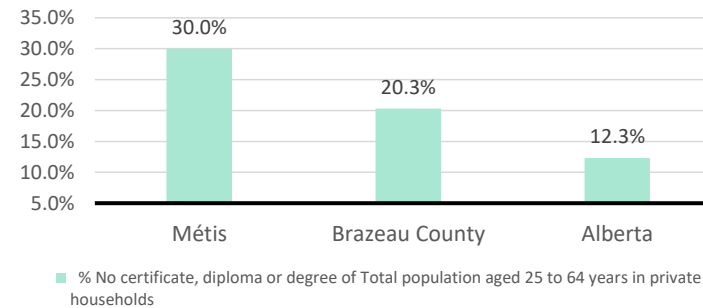
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

Education



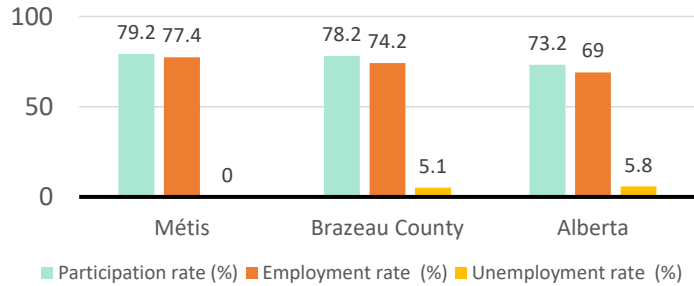

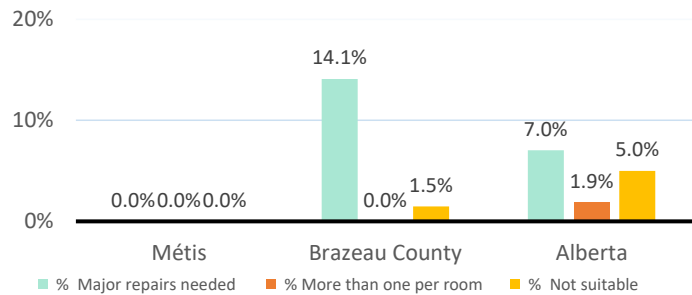
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 79.2%, employment rate is 77.4%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

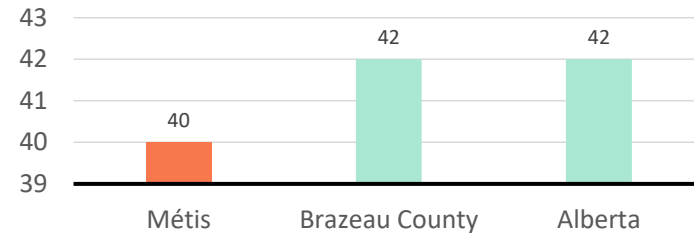
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Brazeau County and Alberta (78.2% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Household Characteristics



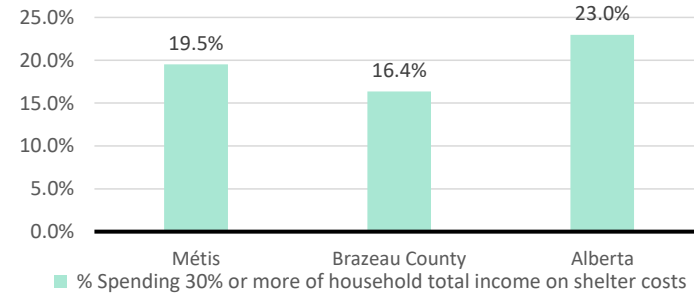
There are 205 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

Shelter Costs



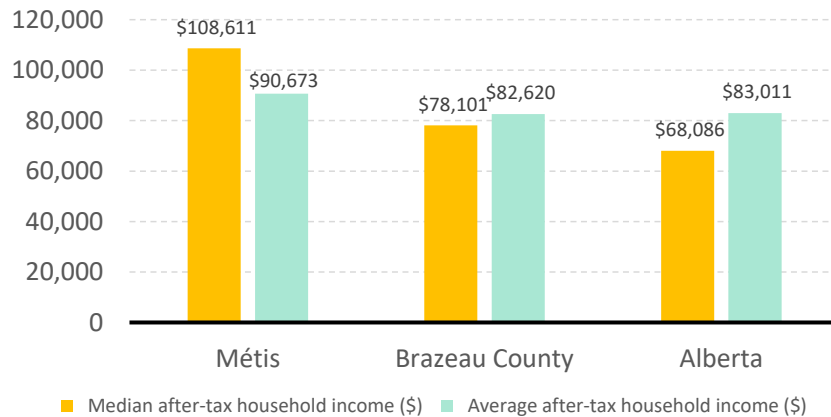
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 40,

Income

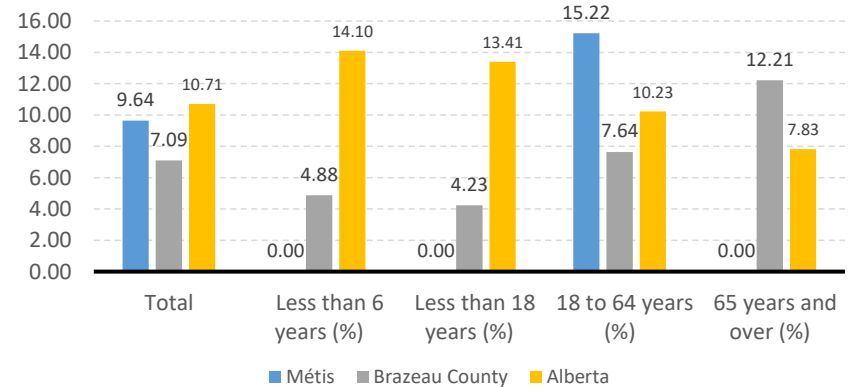
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$108,611, and average after-tax household income is

\$90,673. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Brazeau County and Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 9.64%.

The percentage of low income is 15.22% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and no Métis household reported low income in other age groups.
