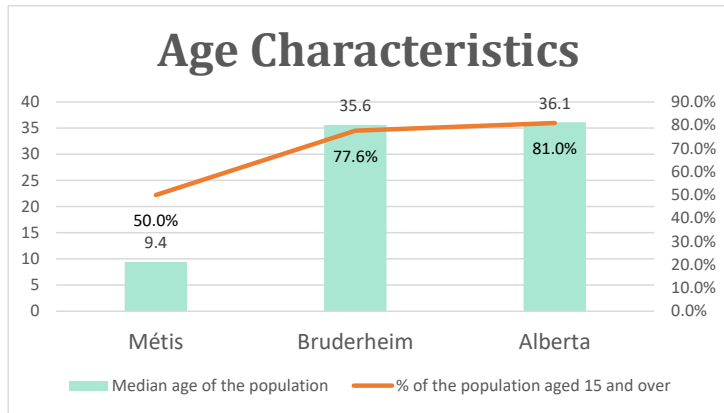

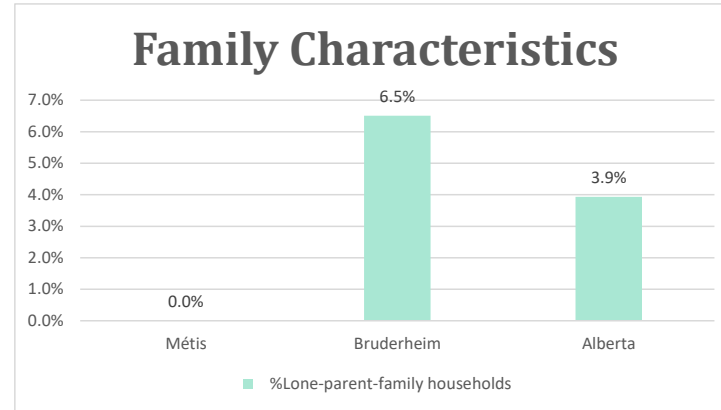

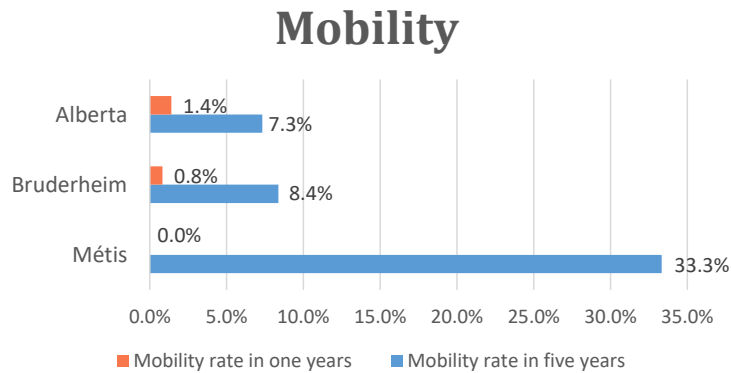
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 180 (Total Métis household is 55), representing 82% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 14.6% of the total population in Bruderheim.



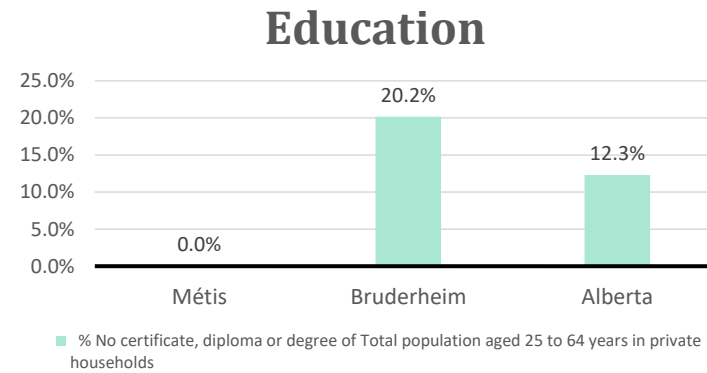
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 9.4 years old, with 50.0% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 35.6 in Bruderheim and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 77.6% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.

No Métis households reported moving in for the last year. 45 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (33.3%).



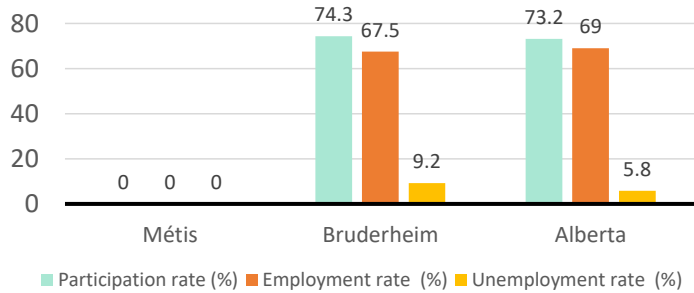
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

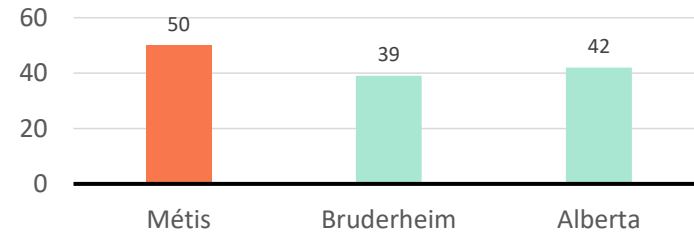

Labour Force Status



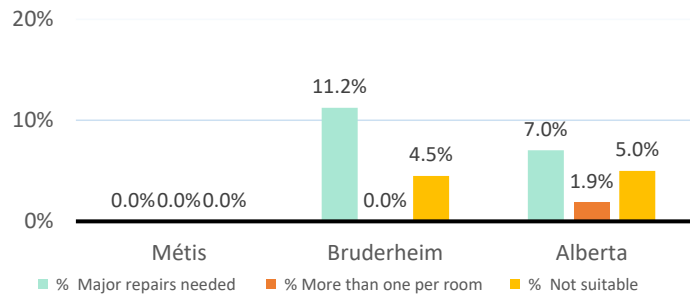

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



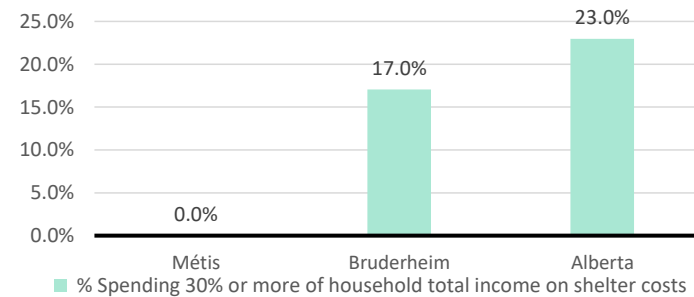
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 50.0 weeks.

Shelter Costs



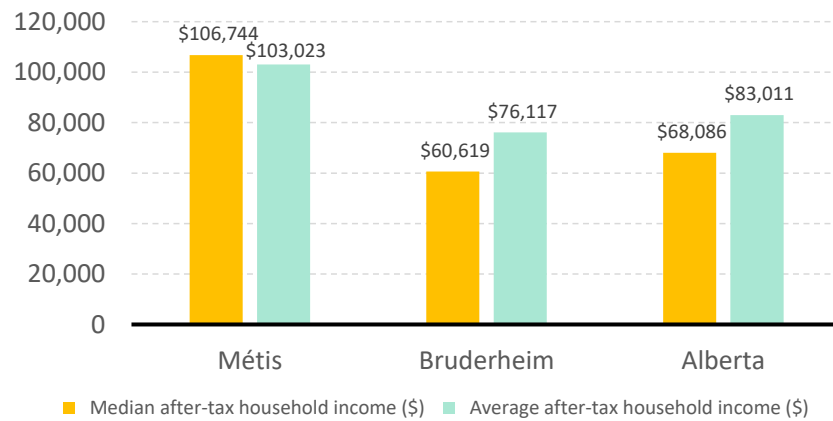
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

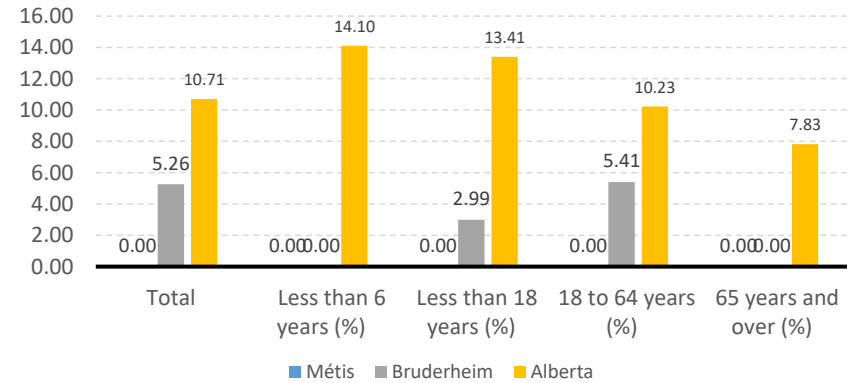
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010
