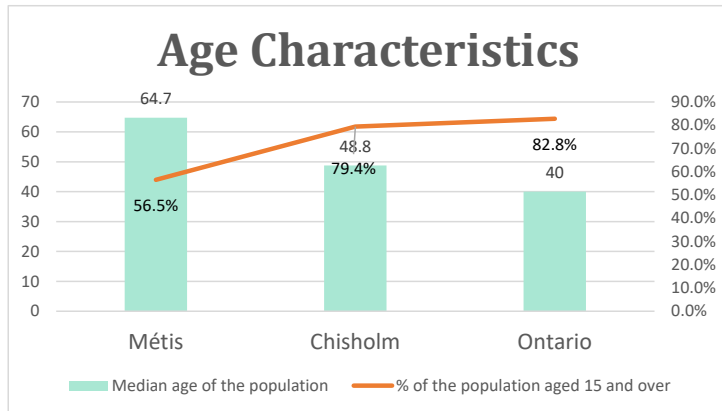

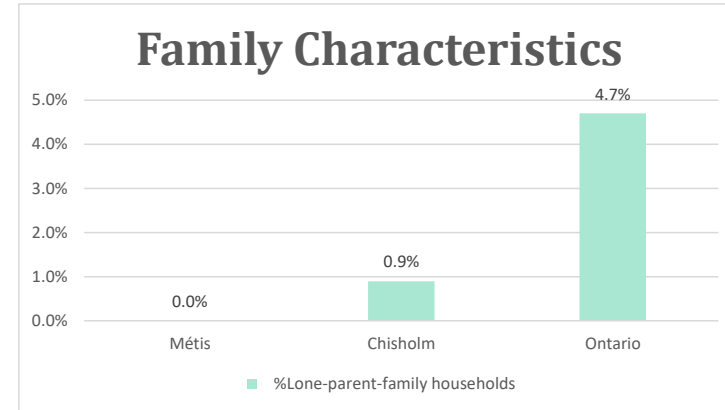

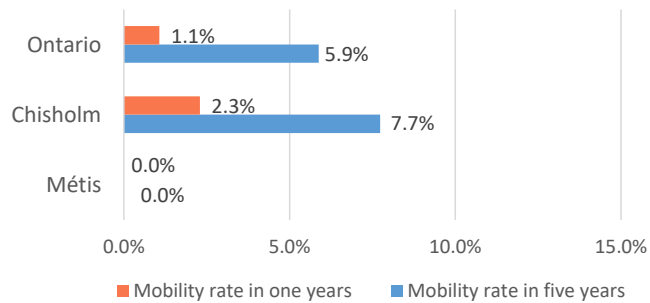

40.0 years old in Ontario, with 79.4% and 82.8% population aged 15 and over respectively.



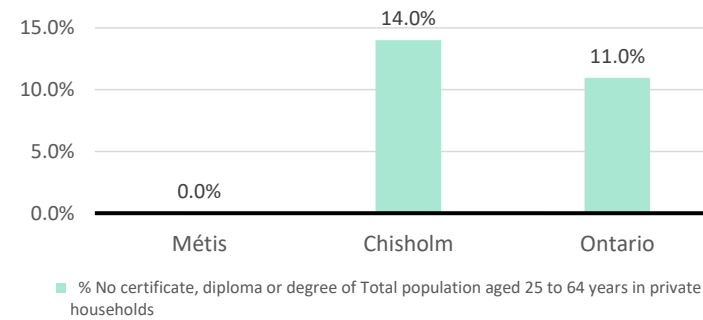

Education



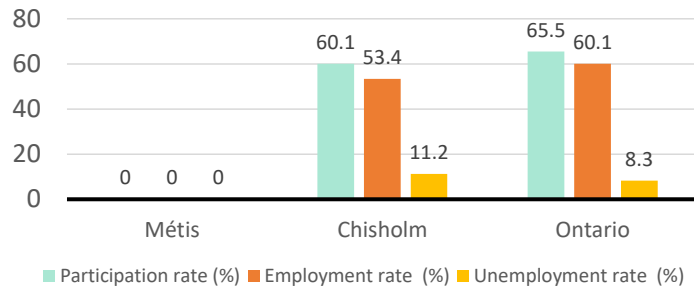
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

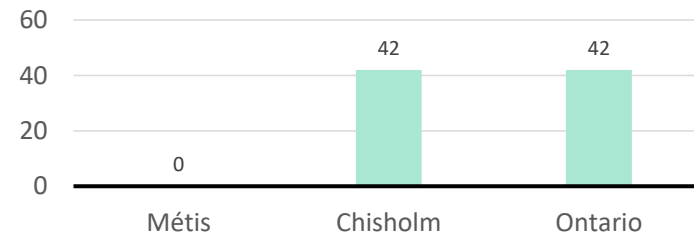

Labour Force Status



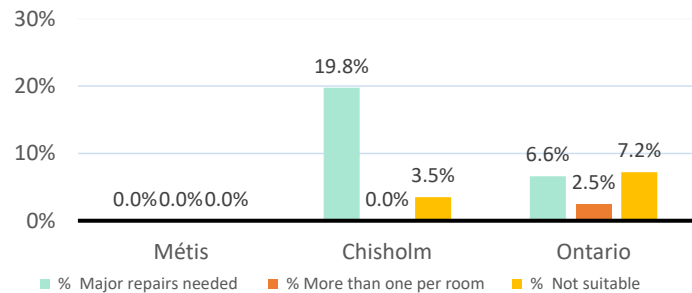

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



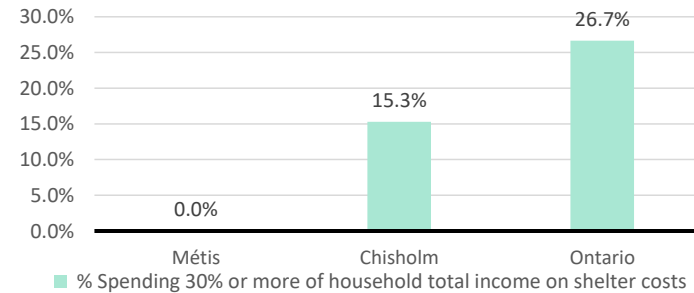

Shelter Costs



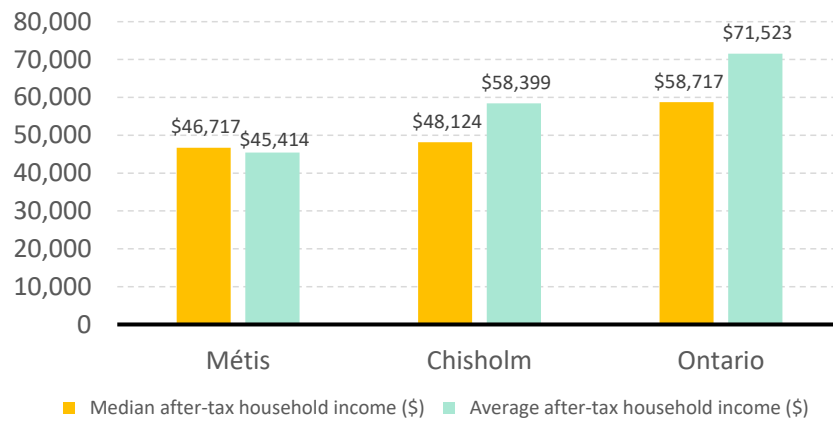
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

Income

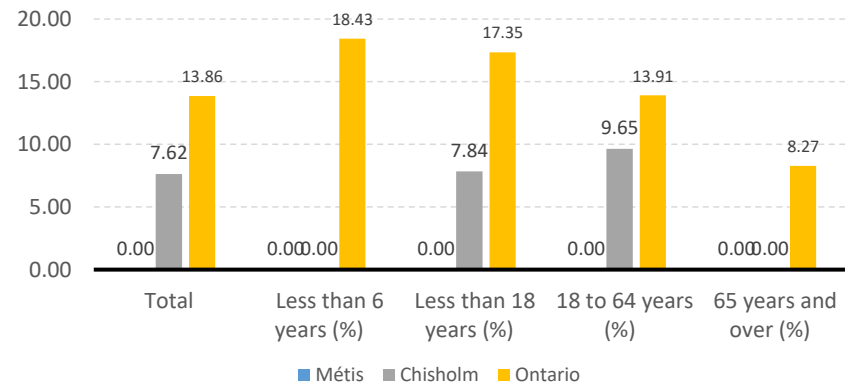
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010
