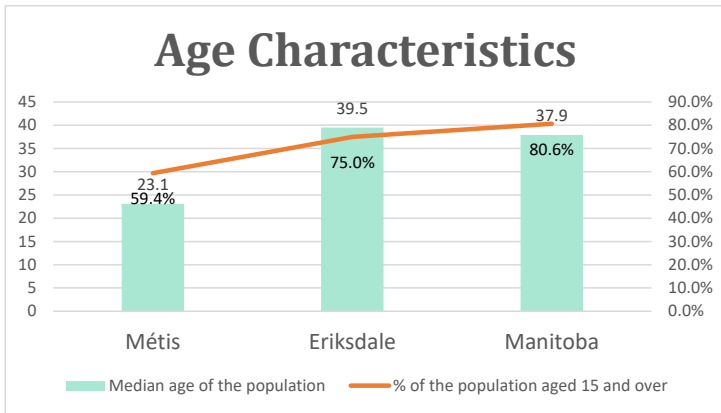

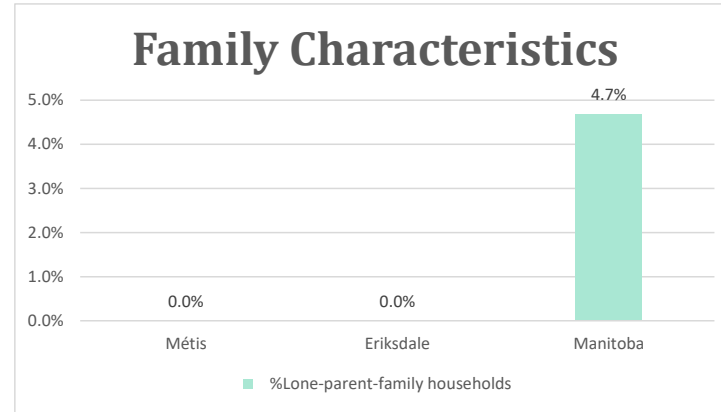

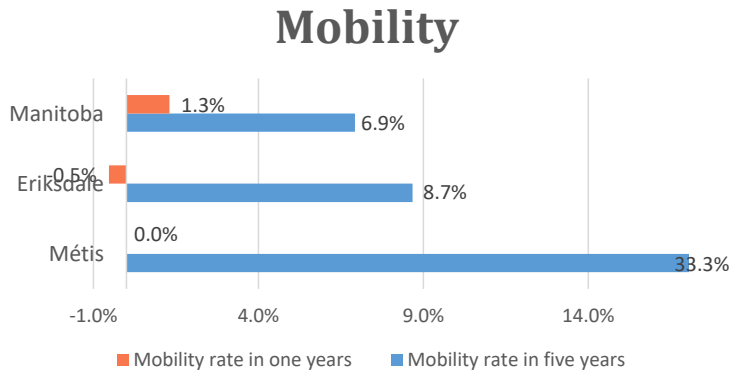
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 160 (Total Métis household is 60), representing 78% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 17.0% of the total population in Eriksdale.



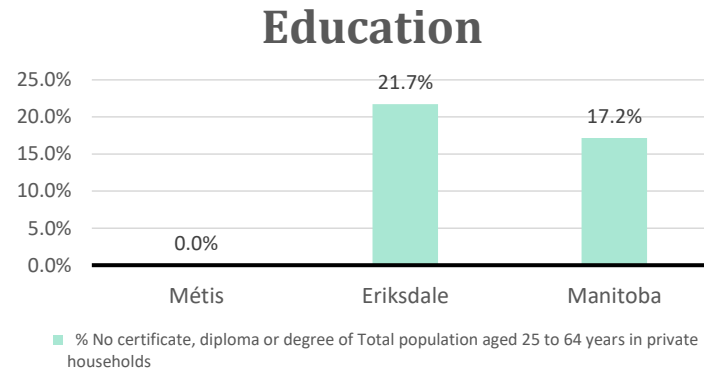
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 23.1 years old, with 59.4% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 39.5 in Eriksdale and 37.9 years old in Manitoba, with 75.0% and 80.6% population aged 15 and over respectively.

No Métis households reported moving in for the last year. 40 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (33.3%).



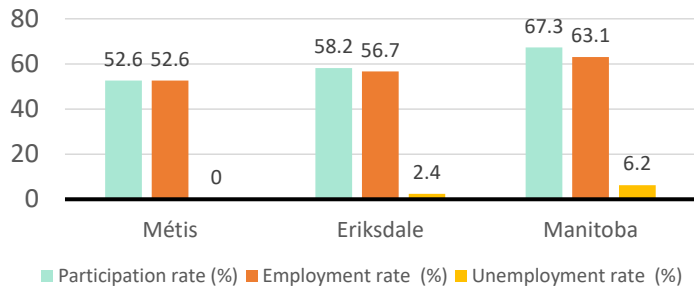
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

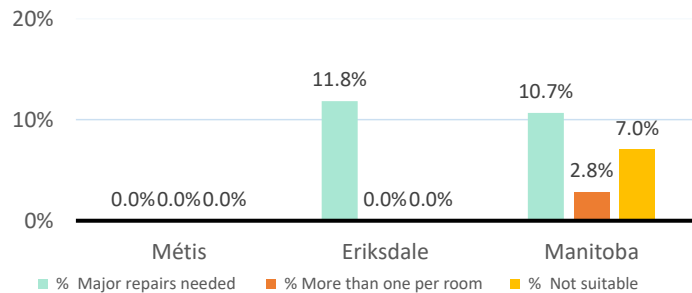
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 52.6%, employment rate is 52.6%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

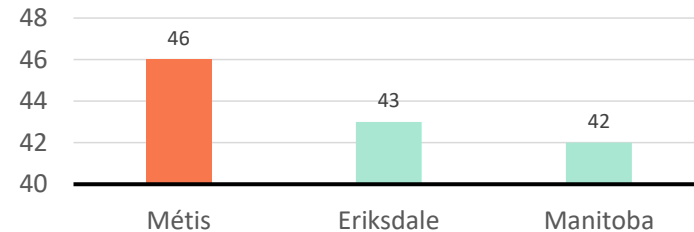
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Eriksdale and Manitoba (58.2% and 67.3%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Household Characteristics



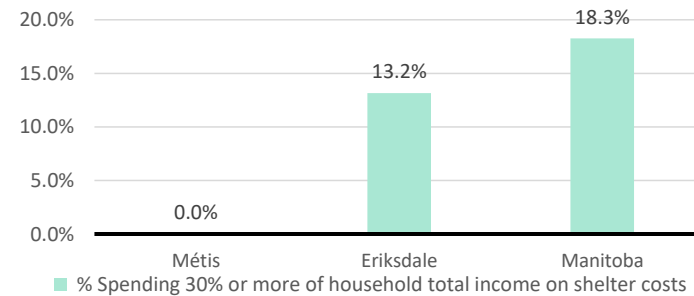
There are 60 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

Shelter Costs



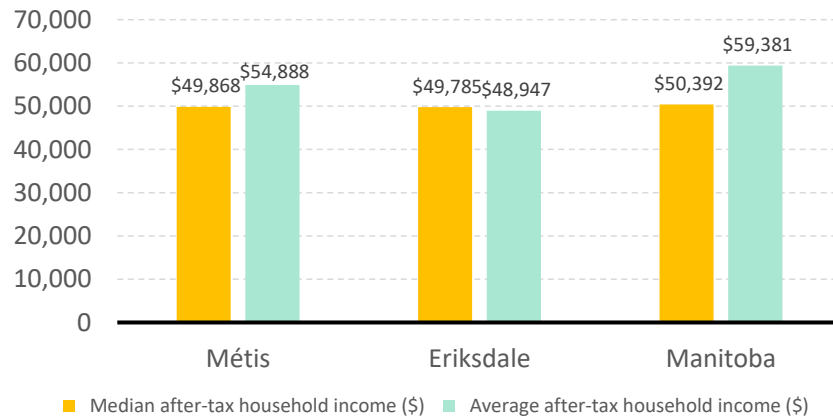
No Métis households reported spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs,

Income

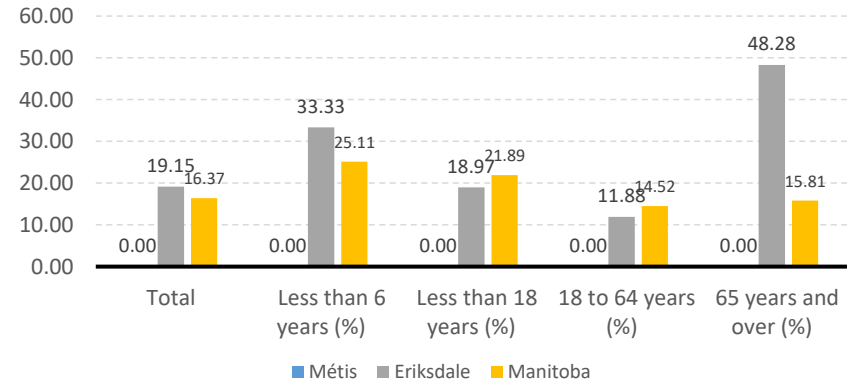
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$49,868, and average after-tax household income is

\$54,888. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Eriksdale, and lower median and average after-tax income than Manitoba.
