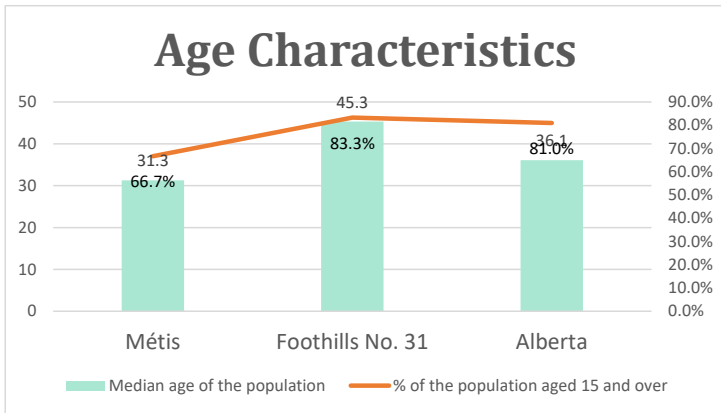

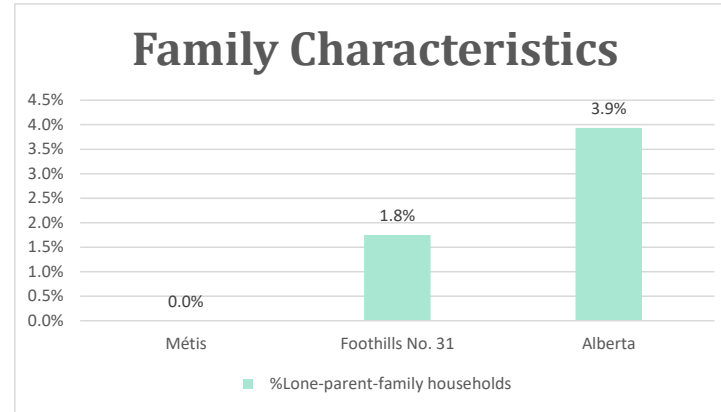

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 450 (Total Métis household is 245), representing 71% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 2.2% of the total population in Foothills No. 31.



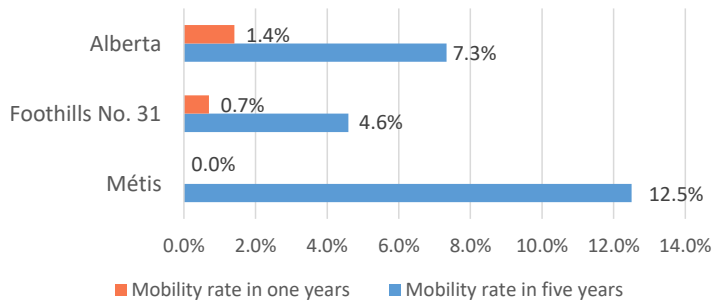
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 31.3 years old, with 66.7% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 45.3 in Foothills No. 31 and

36.1 years old in Alberta, with 83.3% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



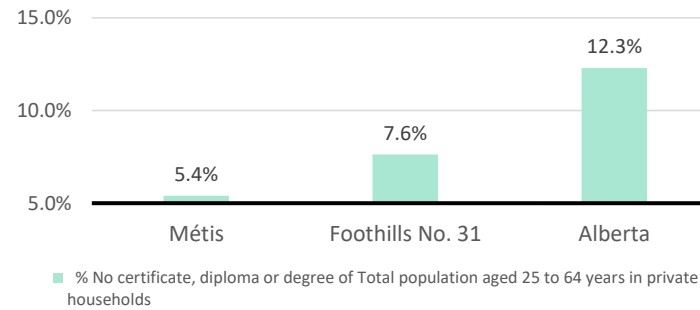
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

Education



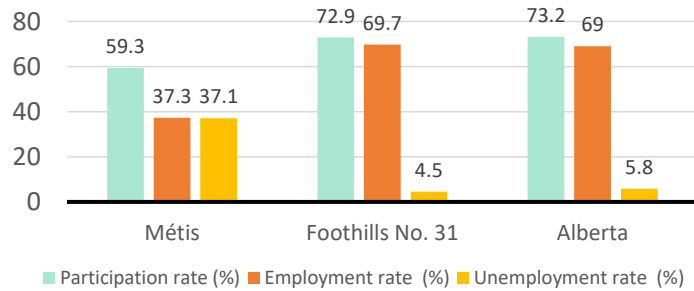
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 5.4% Métis compared to 7.6% in Foothills No. 31 and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

Labor Force & Housing Statistics

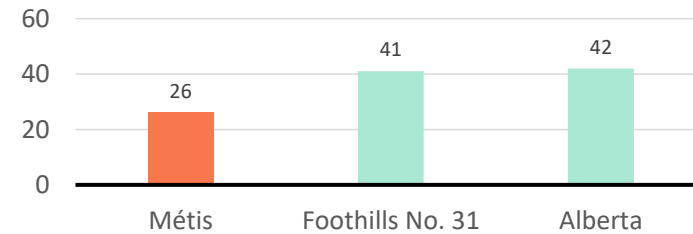
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 59.3%, employment rate is 37.3%, and unemployment rate is 37.1%.

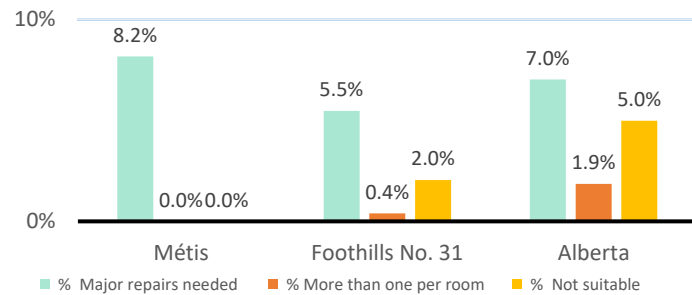
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Foothills No. 31 and Alberta (72.9% and 73.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



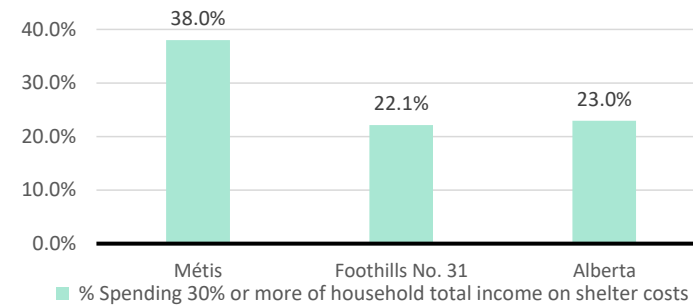
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 26.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 245 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 8.2% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and no Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



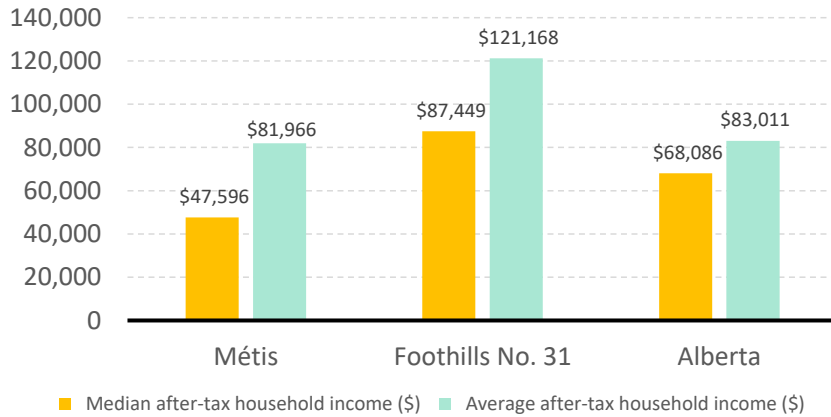
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 95, which is 38.0%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 22.1% of the total population in Foothills No. 31 and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

Income

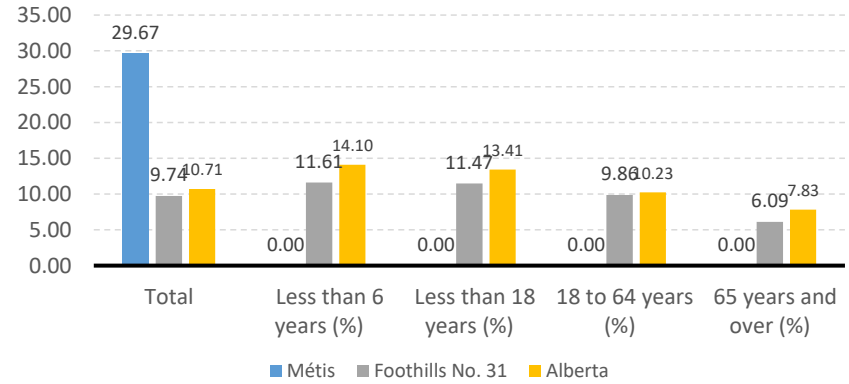
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$47,596, and average after-tax household income is

\$81,966. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Foothills No. 31 and Alberta.

The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 29.67%.
