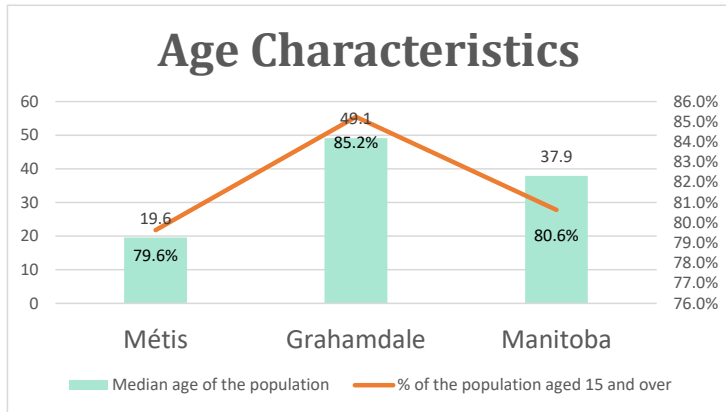

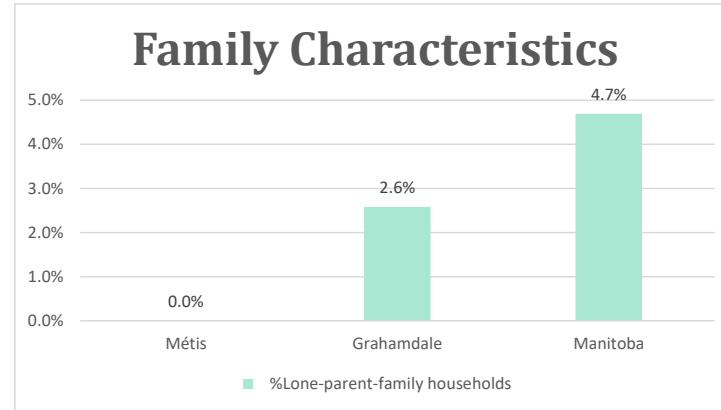

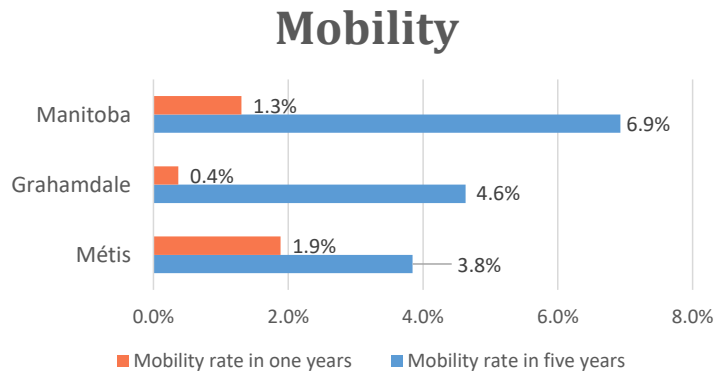
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 270 (Total Métis household is 120), representing 64% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 19.9% of the total population in Grahamdale.



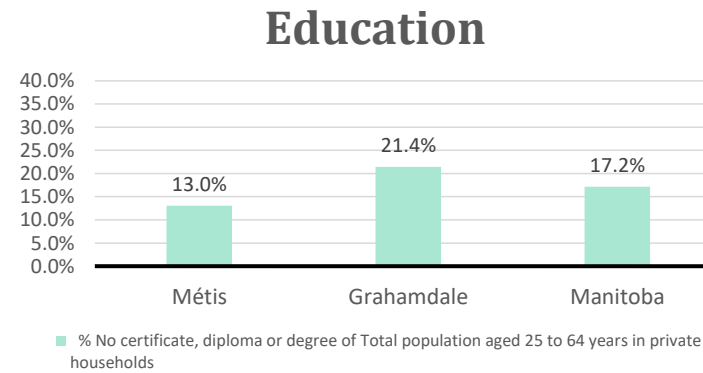
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 19.6 years old, with 79.6% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 49.1 in Grahamdale and 37.9 years old in Manitoba, with 85.2% and 80.6% population aged 15 and over respectively.



No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.



5 Métis households moved in last year (1.9%), 10 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (3.8%).



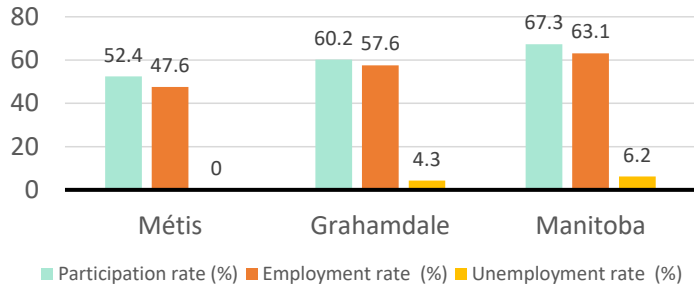
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 13.0% Métis compared to 21.4% in Grahamdale and 17.2% in Manitoba have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

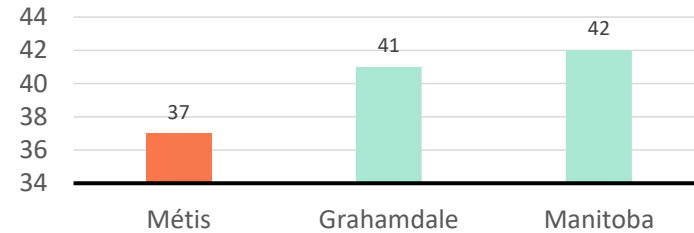
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 52.4%, employment rate is 47.6%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

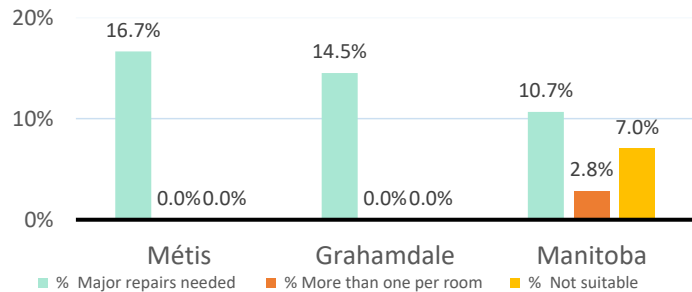
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Grahamdale and Manitoba (60.2% and 67.3%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



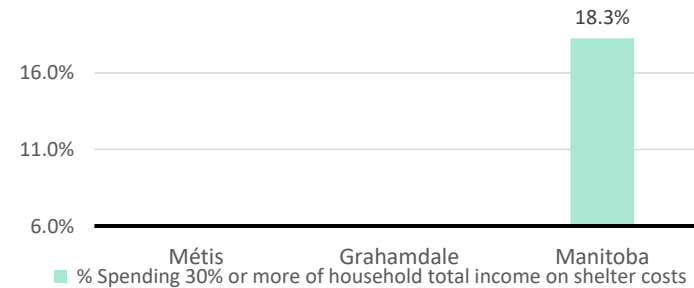
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 37.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 120 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 16.7% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and no Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



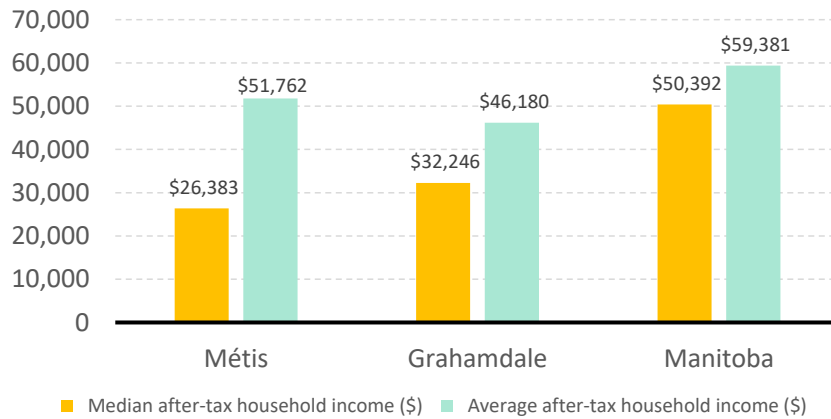
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 0, which is 0.0%

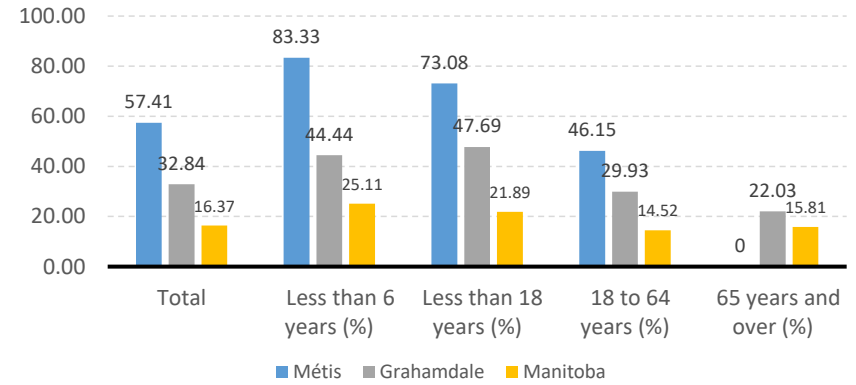
## Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$26,383, and average after-tax household income is \$51,762. Métis has lower median after-tax household income than Grahamdale and Manitoba. Métis has higher average after-tax household income than Grahamdale but lower than Manitoba.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 57.41%.

The percentage of low income is 73.08% for people less than 18 years old, 83.33% for people less than 6 years old, 46.15% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
