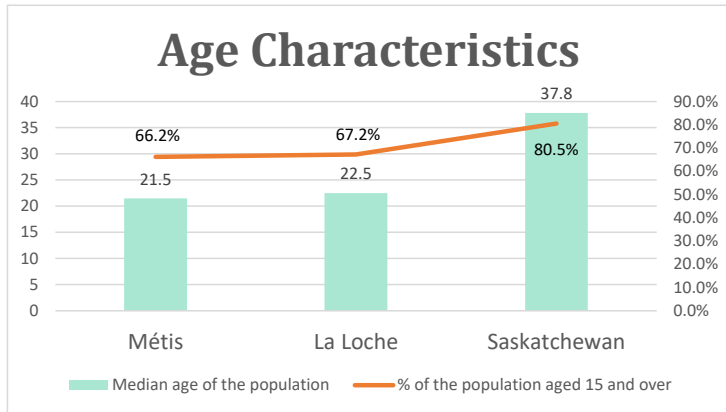

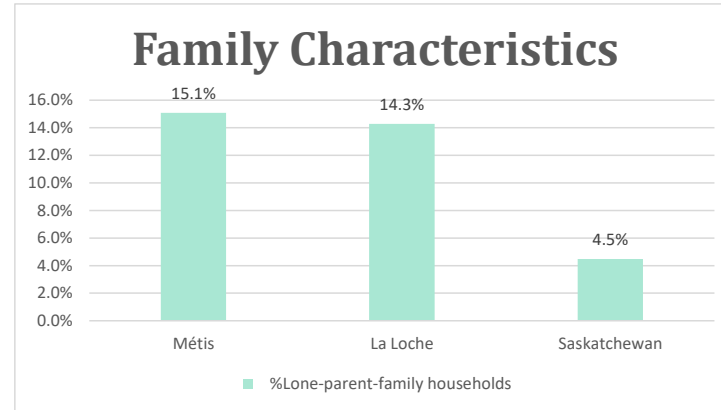

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 1,790 (Total Métis household is 505), representing 71% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 68.2% of the total population in La Loche.

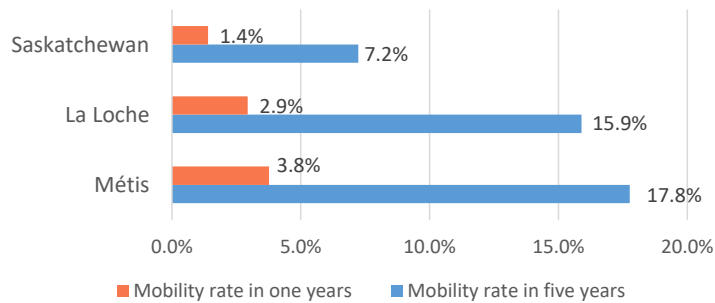


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 21.5 years old, with 66.2% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 22.5 in La Loche and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 67.2% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



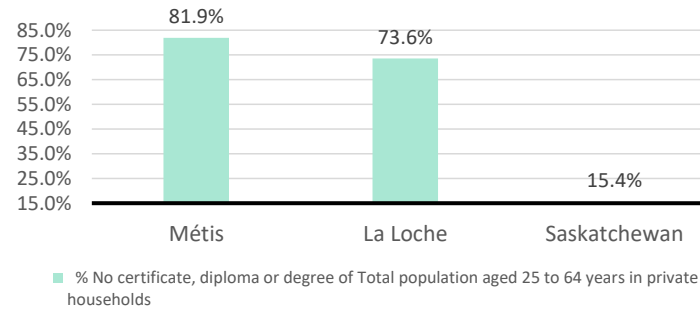
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 270, accounting for 15.1% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



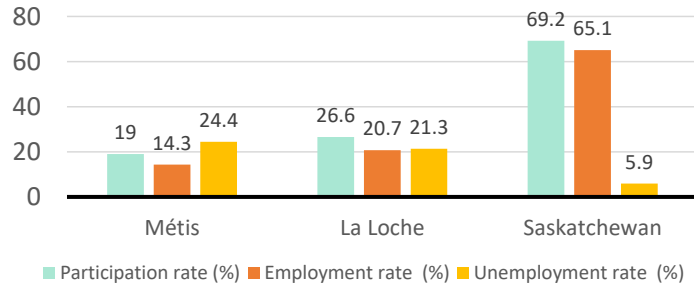
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 81.9% Métis compared to 73.6% in La Loche and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 80.5% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

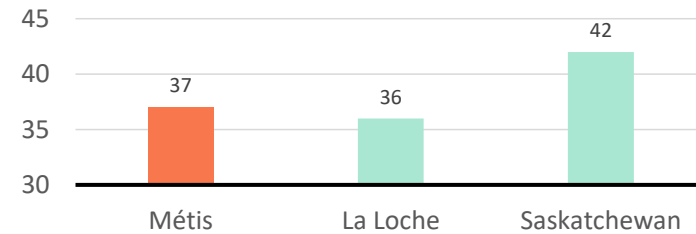
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 19.0%, employment rate is 14.3%, and unemployment rate is 24.4%.

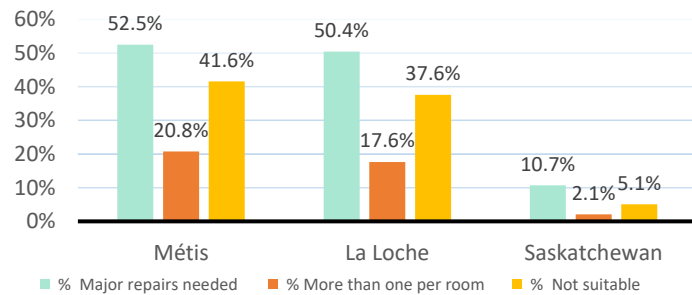
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in La Loche and Saskatchewan (26.6% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



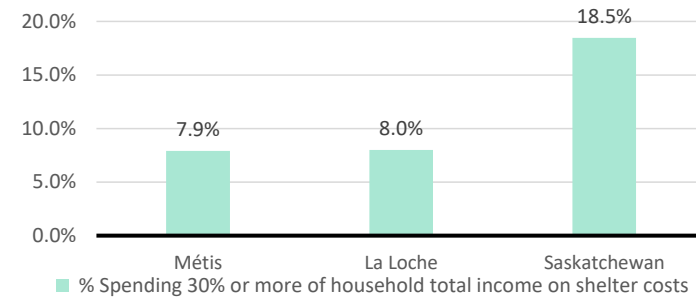
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 37.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 505 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 52.5% need major repairs, 20.8% have more than one person per room, and 41.6% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



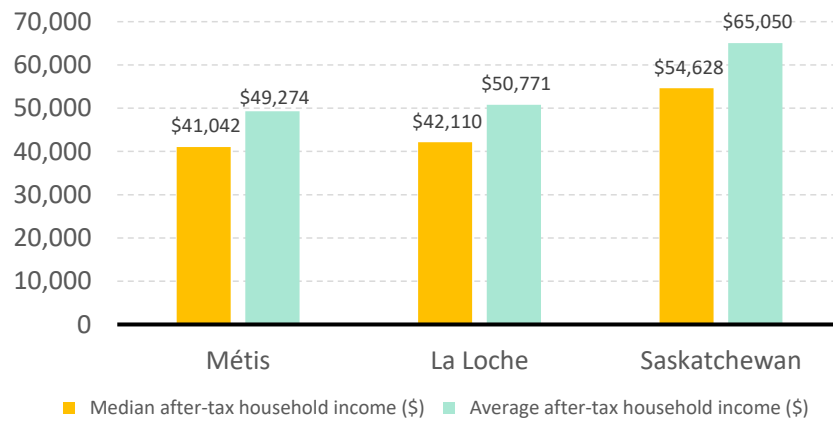
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 40, which is 7.9%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 8.0% of the total population in La Loche and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

Income

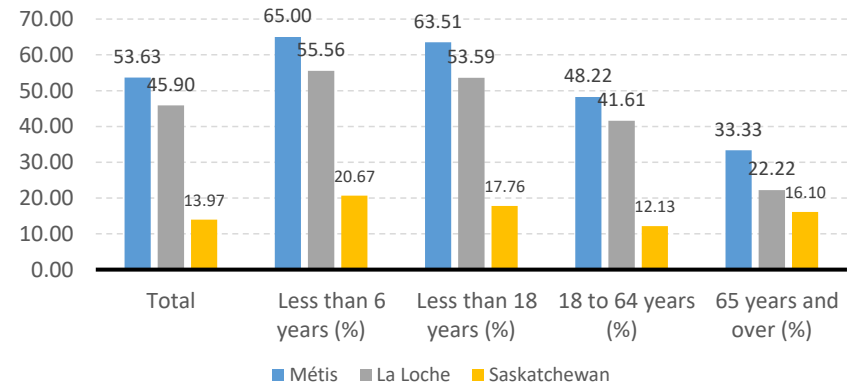
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$41,042, and average after-tax household income is

\$49,274. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than La Loche and Saskatchewan.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 53.63%.

The percentage of low income is 63.51% for people less than 18 years old, 65.00% for people less than 6 years old, 48.22% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 33.33% for people over 65 years old.
