





37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 73.9% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.




25 Métis households moved in last year (2.6%), 60 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (6.5%).

## **Education**






# **Labor Force & Housing Statistics**



Métis participation rate is 73.5%, employment rate is 63.9%, and unemployment rate is 12.3%.


While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Meadow Lake and Saskatchewan (68.2% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is also higher.

## **Household Characteristics**





## **Shelter Costs**




The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 115, which is 21.9%


#### After-Tax Income of Households in 2010

For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$52,023, and average after-tax household income is \$56,758. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Meadow Lake and Saskatchewan.

The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 17.77%.

The percentage of low income is 27.03% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 15.97% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
