



Education






Labor Force & Housing Statistics



Métis participation rate is 70.7%, employment rate is 65.6%, and unemployment rate is 7.2%.


While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Moose Jaw and Saskatchewan (64.5% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is also higher.

Household Characteristics





Shelter Costs




The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 145, which is 23.4%


After-Tax Income of Households in 2010

For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$43,527, and average after-tax household income is \$51,336. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Moose Jaw and Saskatchewan.
