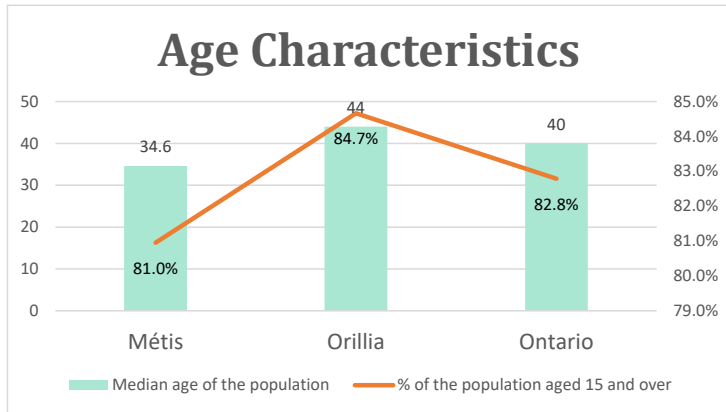

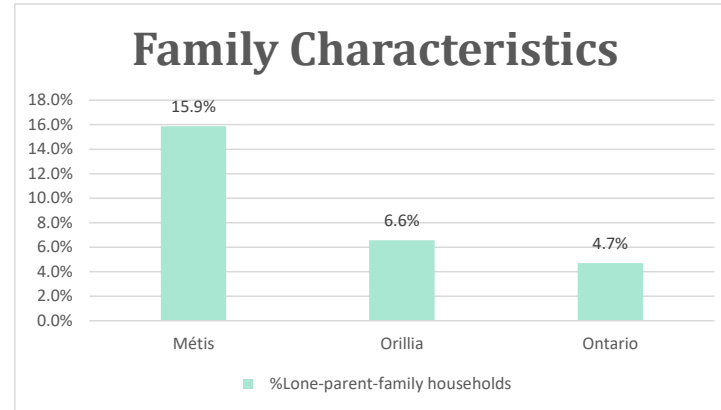

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 315 (Total Métis household is 230), representing 22% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 1.1% of the total population in Orillia.

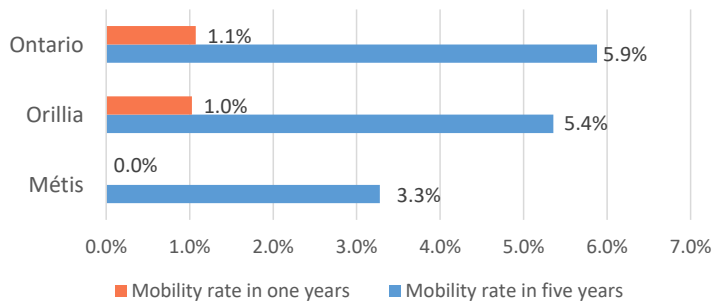


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 34.6 years old, with 81.0% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 44.0 in Orillia and 40.0 years old in Ontario, with 84.7% and 82.8% population aged 15 and over respectively.



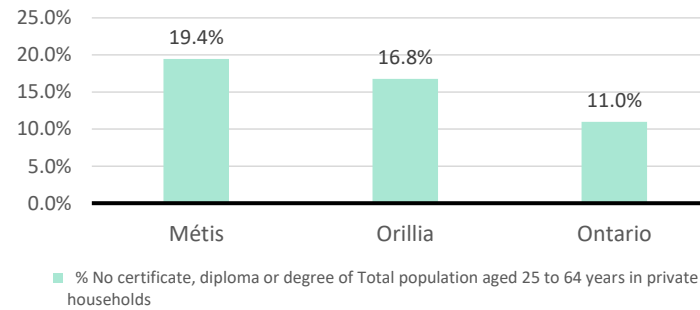
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 50, accounting for 15.9% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



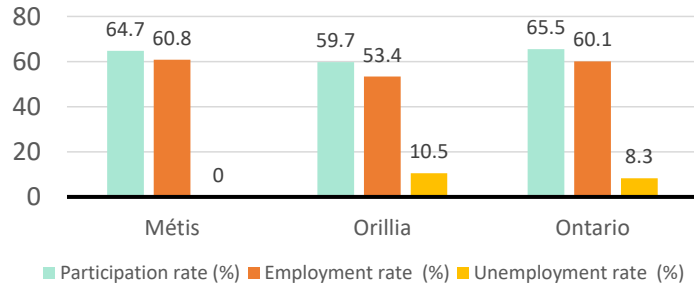
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

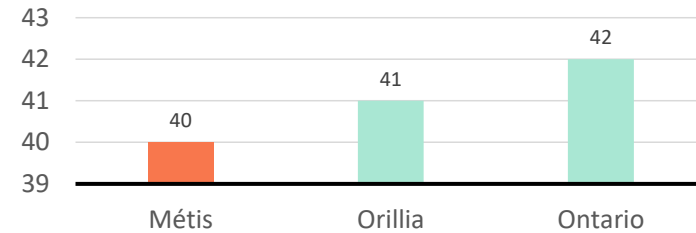
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 64.7%, employment rate is 60.8%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

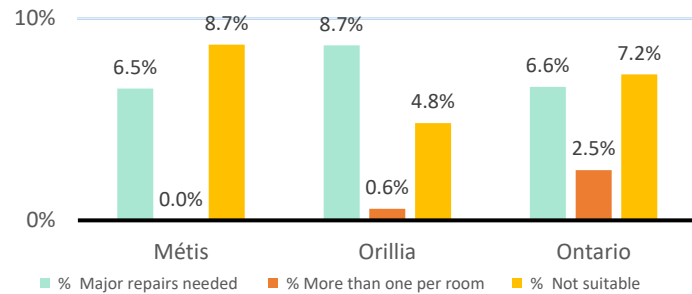
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Orillia and lower than Ontario (59.7% and 65.5%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



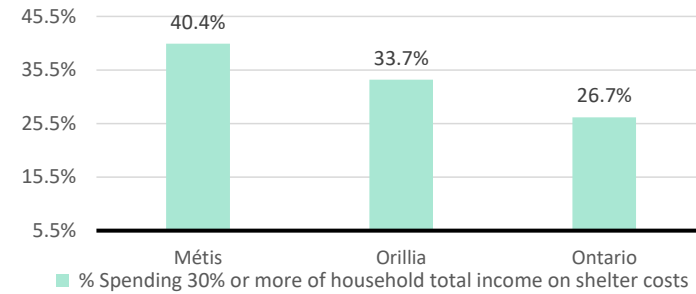
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 230 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 6.5% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 8.7% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



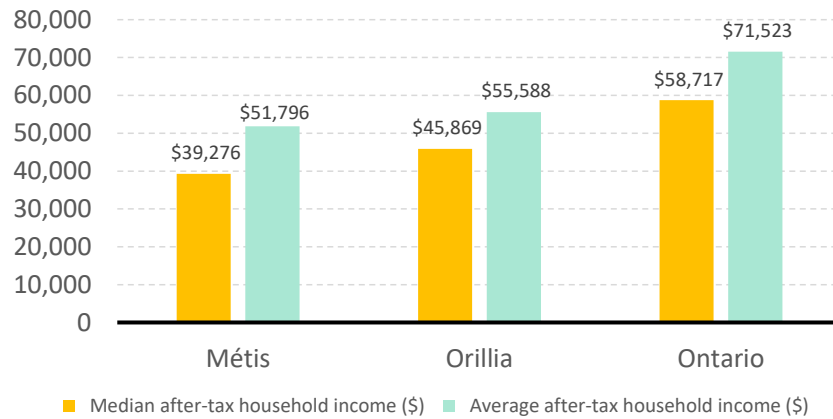
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 95, which is 40.4%

of the total private dwellings occupied by an Métis household, compared to 33.7% of the total population in Orillia and 26.7% of the total population in Ontario.

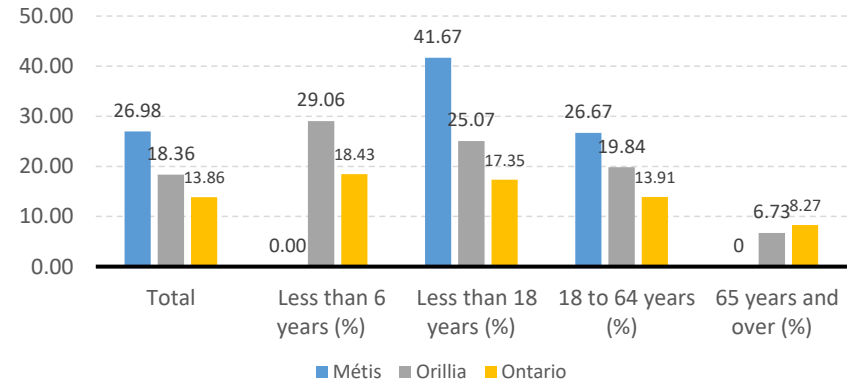
Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$39,276, and average after-tax household income is \$51,796. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Orillia and Ontario.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 26.98%.

The percentage of low income is 41.67% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 26.67% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
