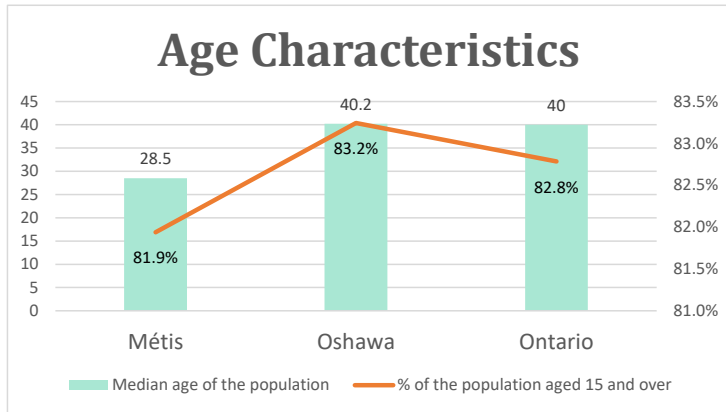

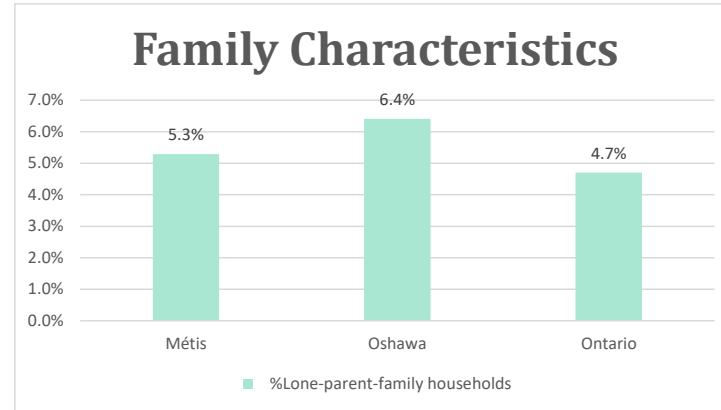

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 1,135 (Total Métis household is 635), representing 39% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 0.8% of the total population in Oshawa.

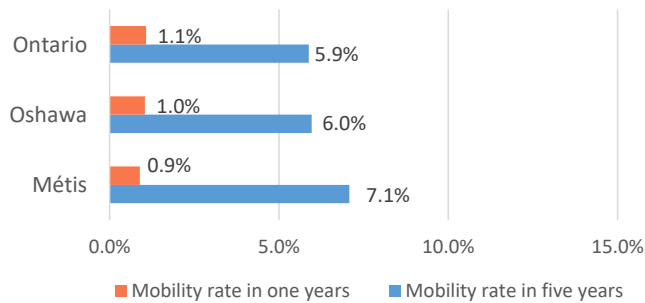


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 28.5 years old, with 81.9% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 40.2 in Oshawa and 40.0 years old in Ontario, with 83.2% and 82.8% population aged 15 and over respectively.



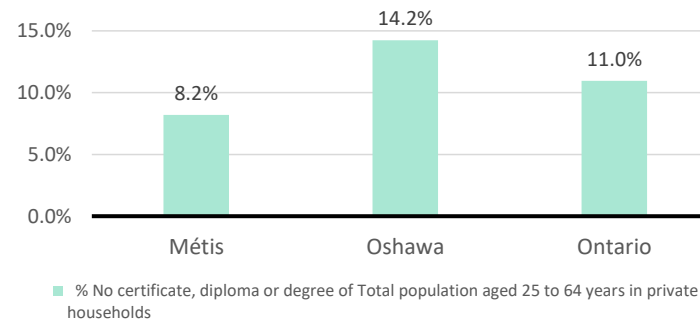
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 60, accounting for 5.3% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



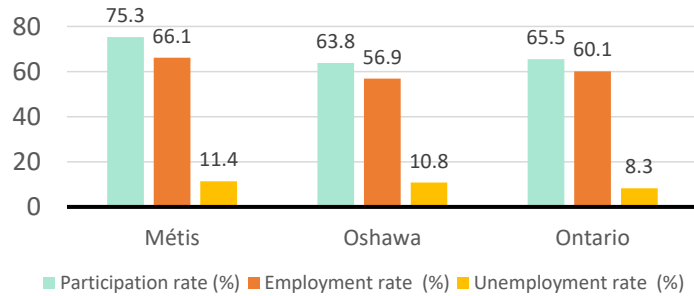
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 8.2% Métis compared to 14.2% in Oshawa and 11.0% in Ontario have no certificate, diploma or degree.

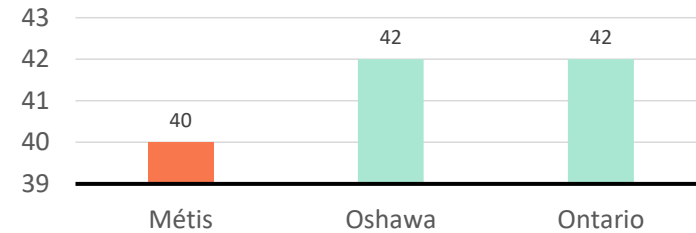
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 75.3%, employment rate is 66.1%, and unemployment rate is 11.4%.

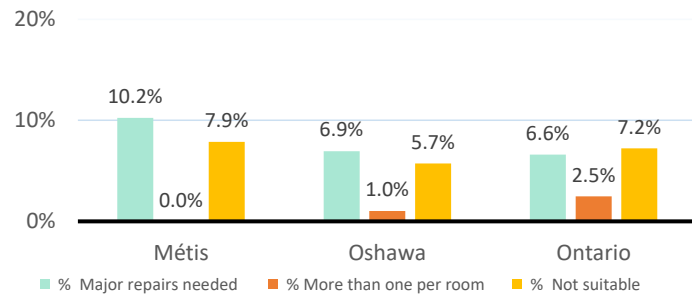
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Oshawa and Ontario (63.8% and 65.5%), unemployment rate is also higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



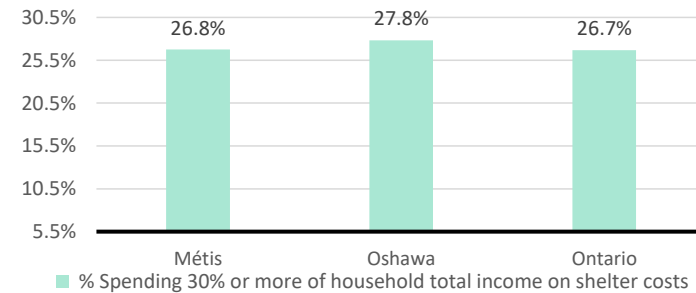
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 635 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 10.2% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 7.9% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



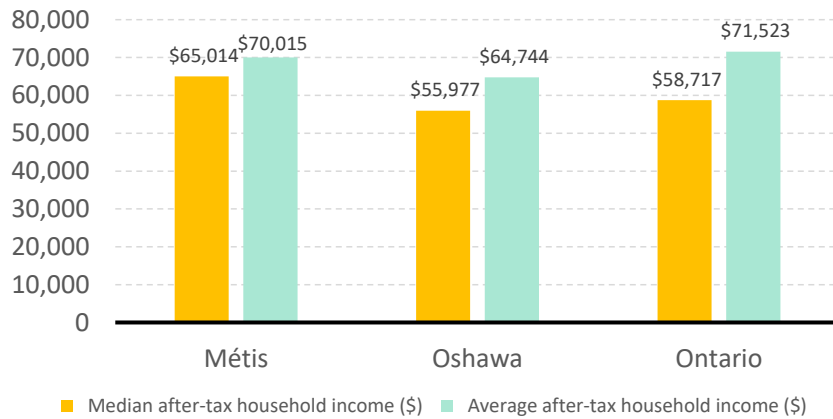
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 170, which is 26.8%

of the total private dwellings occupied by an Métis household, compared to 27.8% of the total population in Oshawa and 26.7% of the total population in Ontario.

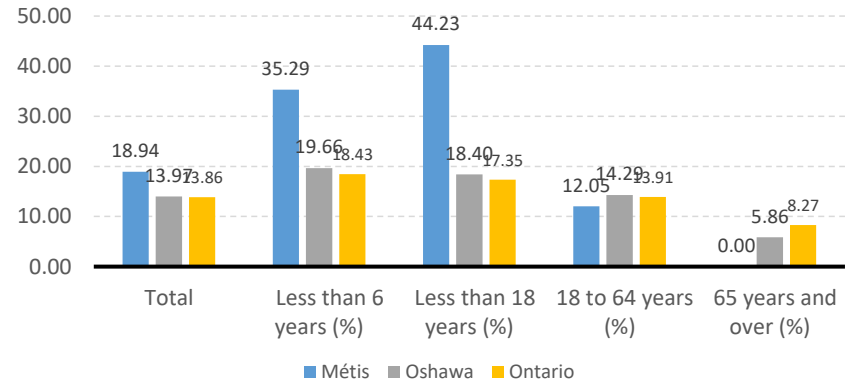
Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$65,014, and average after-tax household income is \$70,015. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Oshawa, and higher median and lower average after-tax income than Ontario.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 18.94%.

The percentage of low income is 44.23% for people less than 18 years old, 35.29% for people less than 6 years old, 12.05% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
