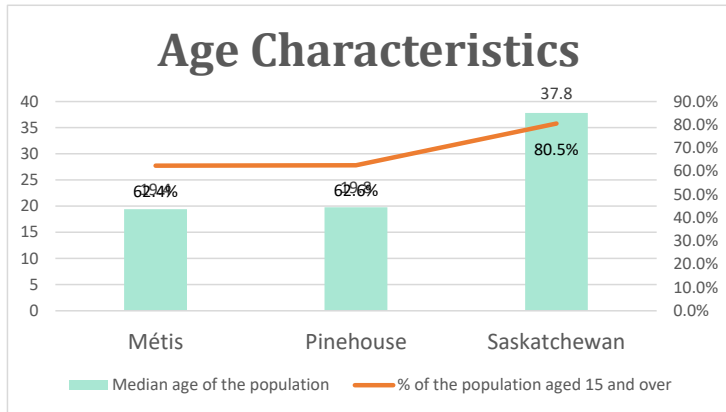

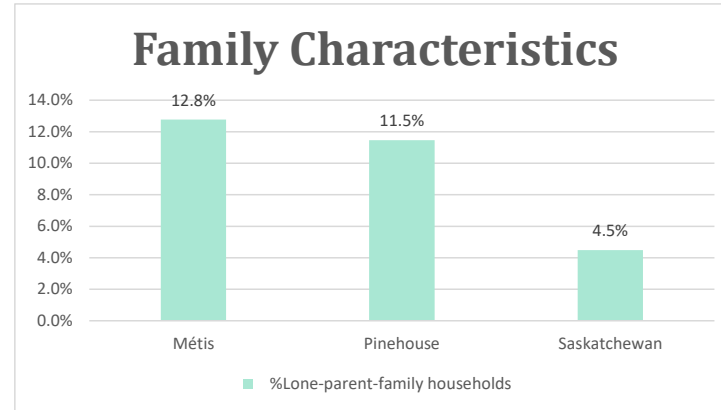

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 705 (Total Métis household is 170), representing 66% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 62.1% of the total population in Pinehouse.

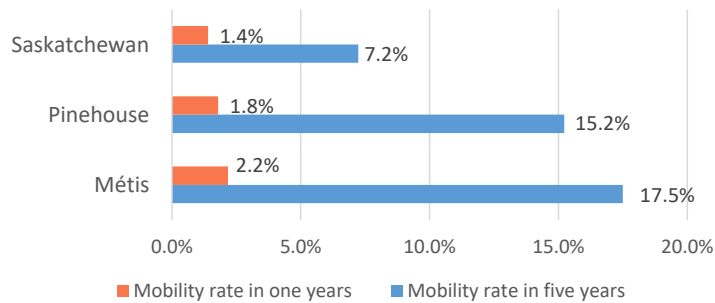


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 19.4 years old, with 62.4% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 19.8 in Pinehouse and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 62.6% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



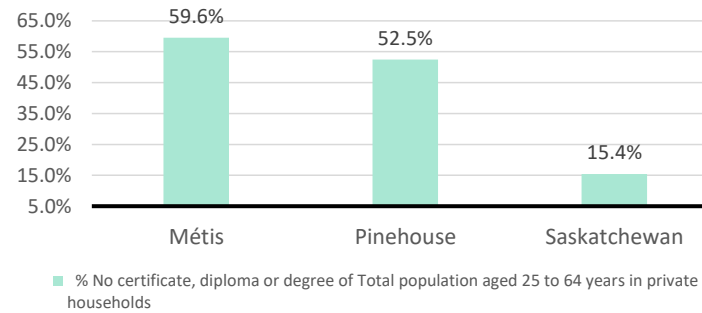
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 90, accounting for 12.8% of the total Métis single private households.

15 Métis households moved in last year (2.2%), 105 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (17.5%).

Education



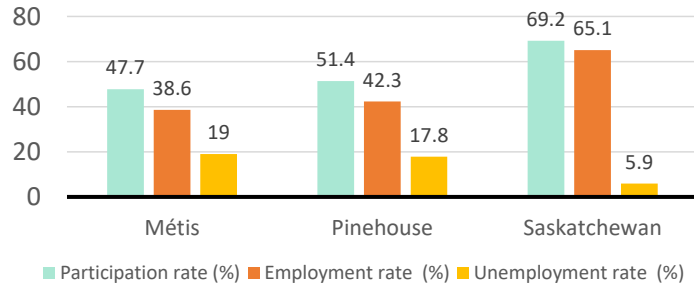
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 59.6% Métis compared to 52.5% in Pinehouse and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 46.7% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

Labor Force & Housing Statistics

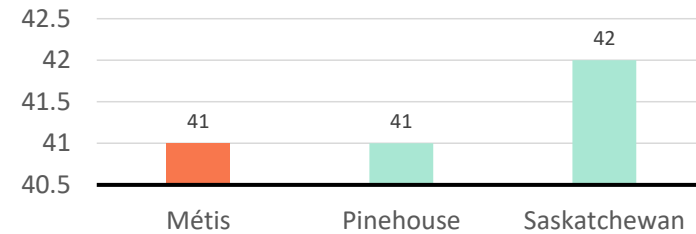
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 47.7%, employment rate is 38.6%, and unemployment rate is 19.0%.

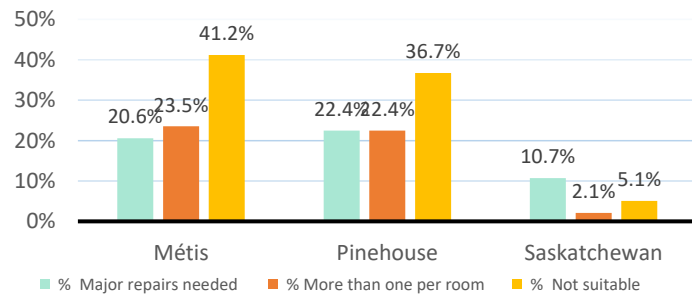
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Pinehouse and Saskatchewan (51.4% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



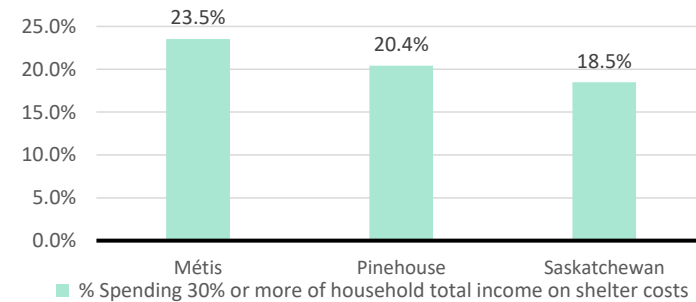
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 41.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 170 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 20.6% need major repairs, 23.5% have more than one person per room, and 41.2% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



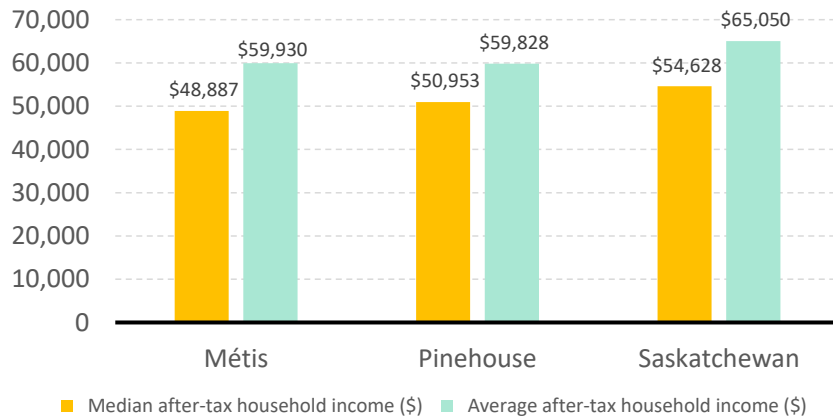
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 40, which is 23.5%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 20.4% of the total population in Pinehouse and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

Income

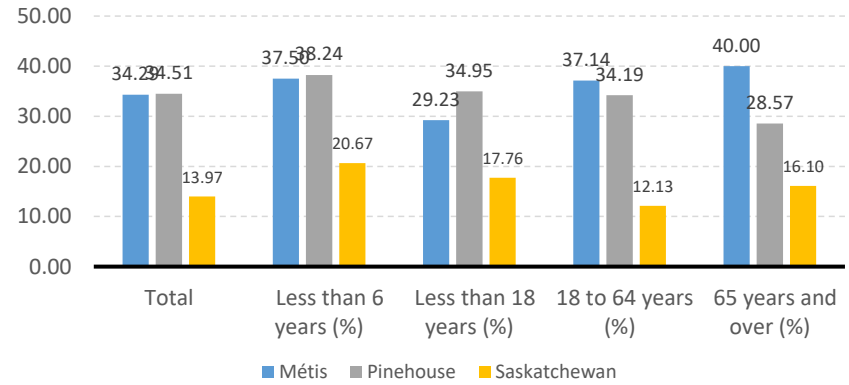
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$48,887, and average after-tax household income is

\$59,930. Métis has lower median and higher average after-tax income than Pinehouse, and lower median and average after-tax income than Saskatchewan.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 34.29%.

The percentage of low income is 29.23% for people less than 18 years old, 37.50% for people less than 6 years old, 37.14% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 40.00% for people over 65 years old.
