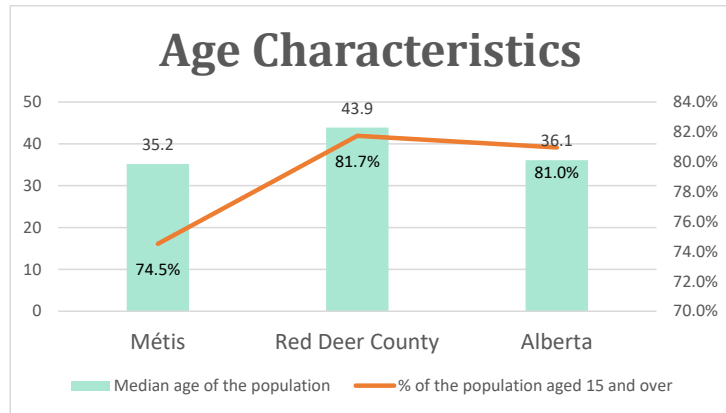

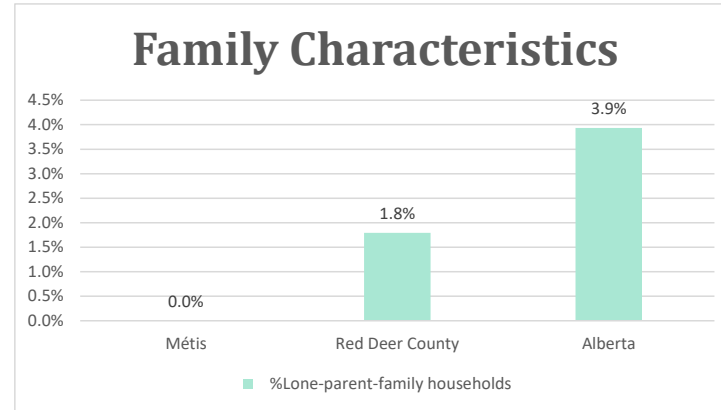

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 255 (Total Métis household is 130), representing 43% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 1.5% of the total population in Red Deer County.

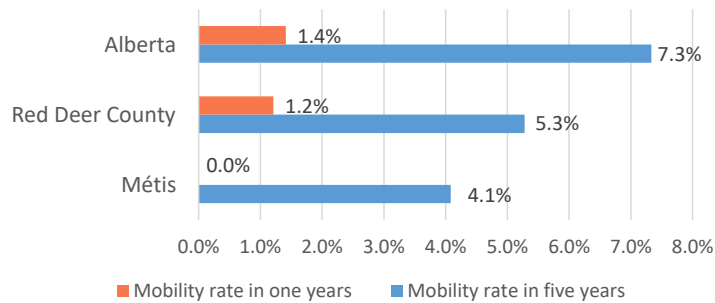


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 35.2 years old, with 74.5% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 43.9 in Red Deer County and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 81.7% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



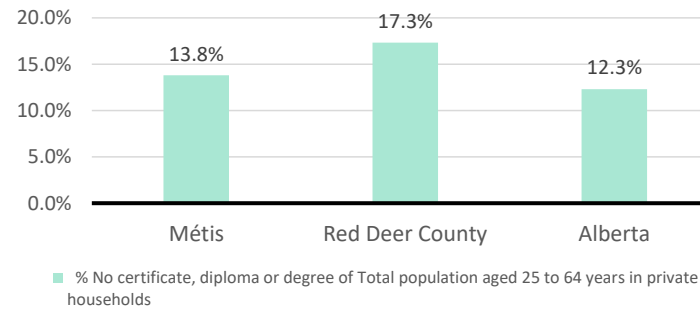
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

Education



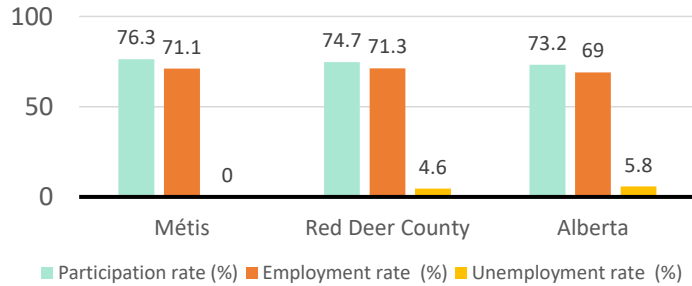
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 13.8% Métis compared to 17.3% in Red Deer County and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

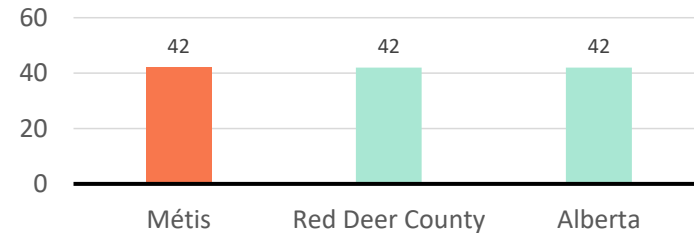
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 76.3%, employment rate is 71.1%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

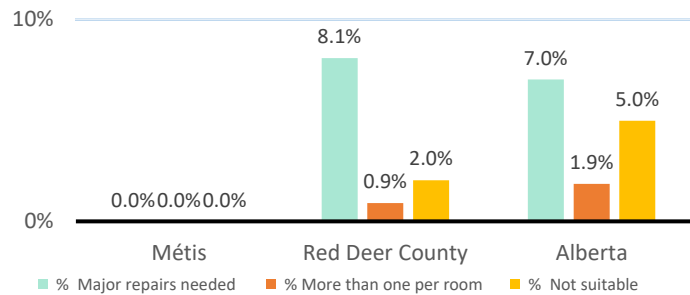
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Red Deer County and Alberta (74.7% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



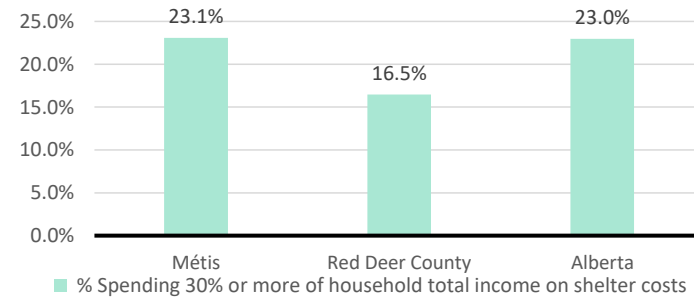
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 42.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 130 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

Shelter Costs



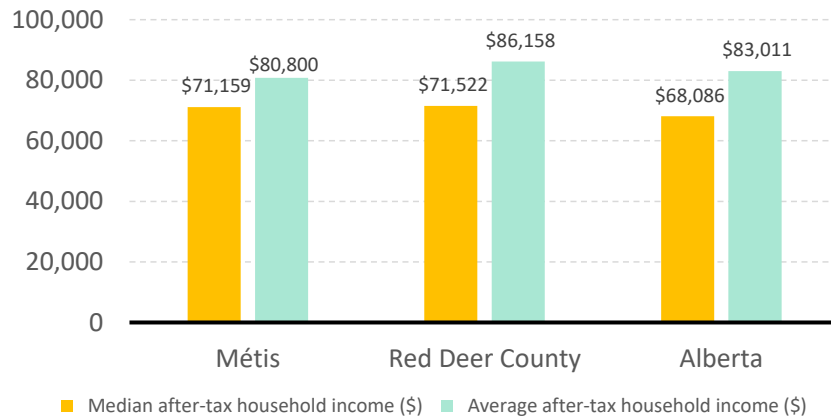
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 30, which is 23.1%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 16.5% of the total population in Red Deer County and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

Income

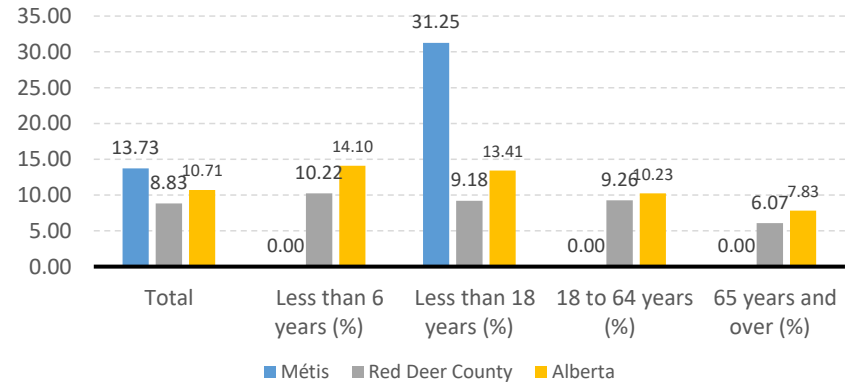
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$71,159, and average after-tax household income is

\$80,800. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Red Deer County, and higher median and lower average after-tax income than Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 13.73%.

The percentage of low income is 31.25% for people less than 18 years old, no Métis household reported low income in other age groups.
