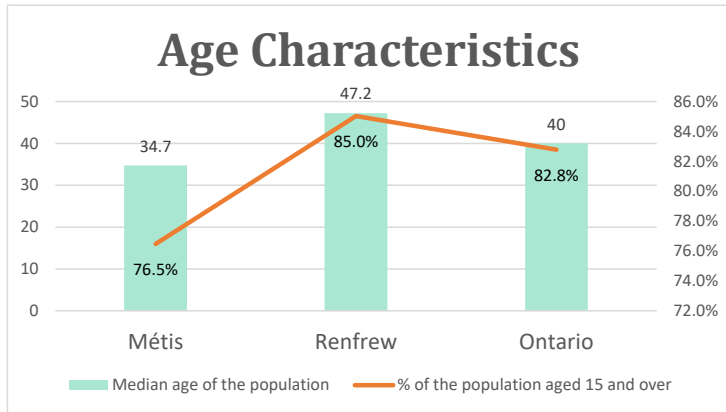

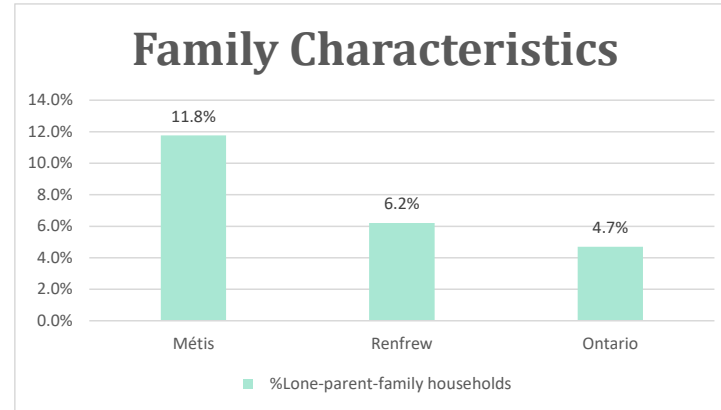

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 255 (Total Métis household is 150), representing 55% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.3% of the total population in Renfrew.



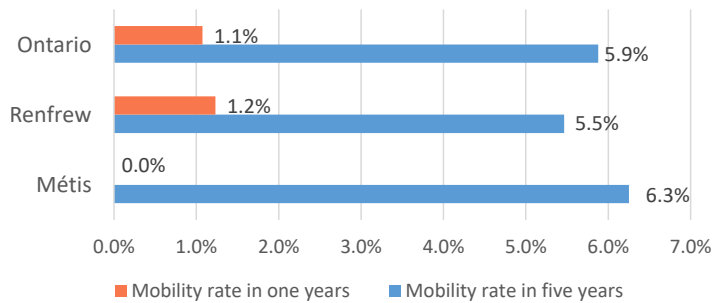
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 34.7 years old, with 76.5% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 47.2 in Renfrew and

40.0 years old in Ontario, with 85.0% and 82.8% population aged 15 and over respectively.



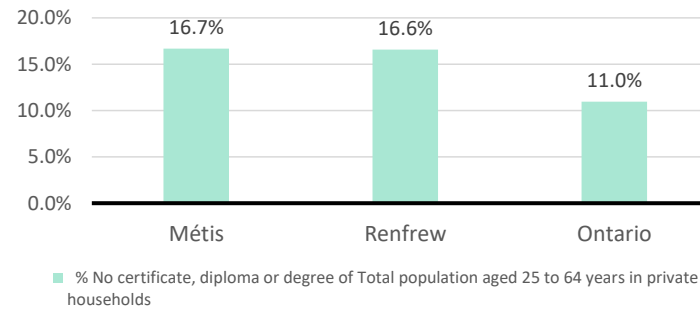
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 30, accounting for 11.8% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



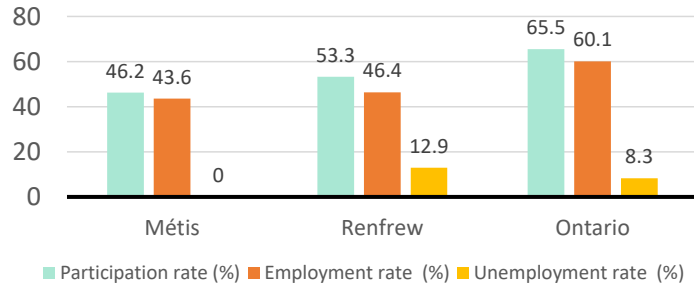
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 16.7% Métis compared to 16.6% in Renfrew and 11.0% in Ontario have no certificate, diploma or degree.

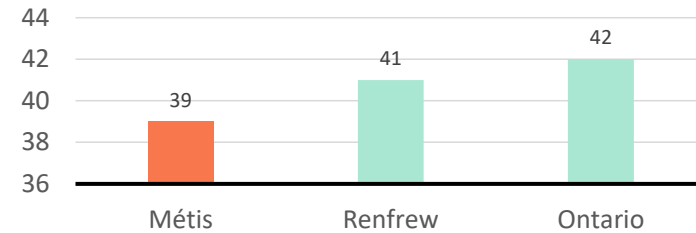
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 46.2%, employment rate is 43.6%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

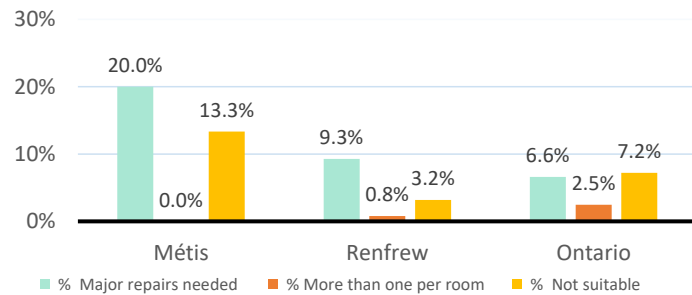
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Renfrew and Ontario (53.3% and 65.5%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



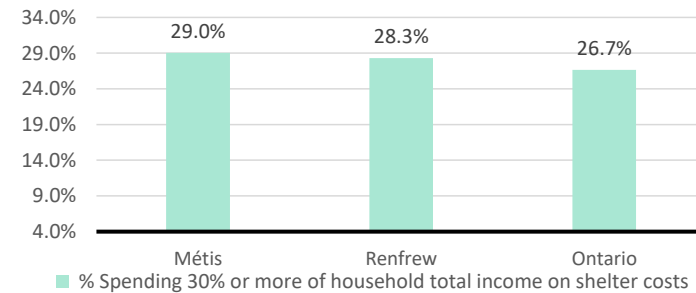
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 39.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 150 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 20.0% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 13.3% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



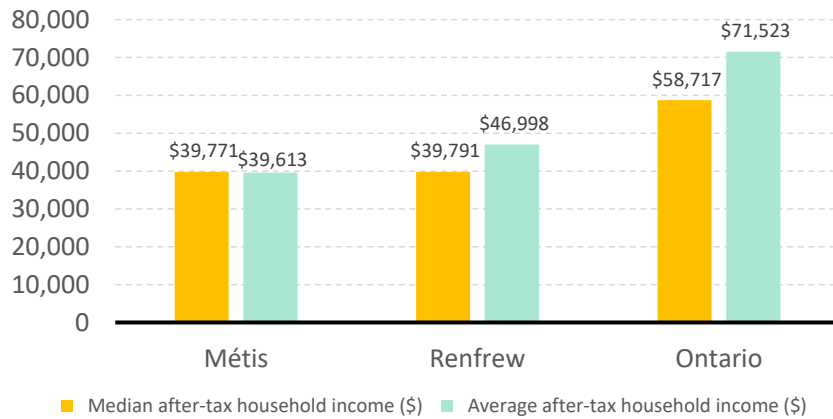
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 45, which is 29.0%

of the total private dwellings occupied by an Métis household, compared to 28.3% of the total population in Renfrew and 26.7% of the total population in Ontario.

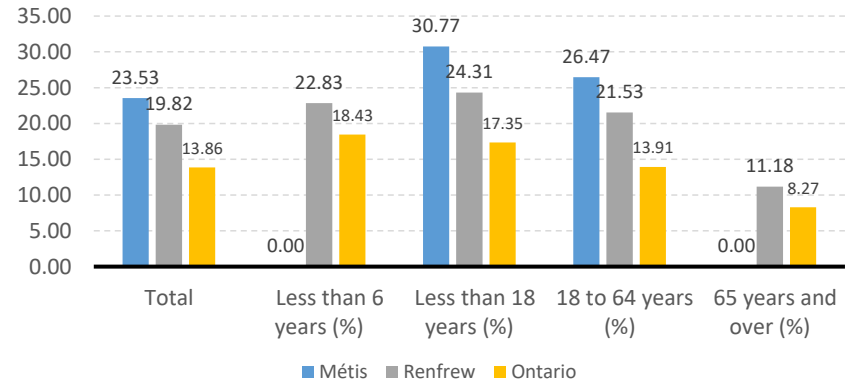
Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$39,771, and average after-tax household income is \$39,613. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Renfrew and Ontario.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 23.53%.

The percentage of low income is 30.77% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 26.47% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
