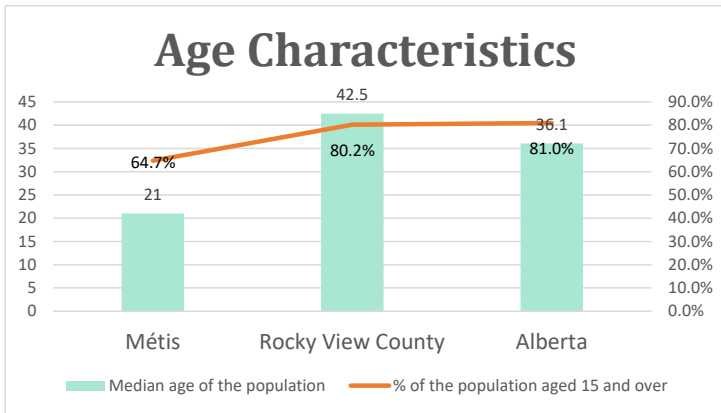


# Rocky View County, AB

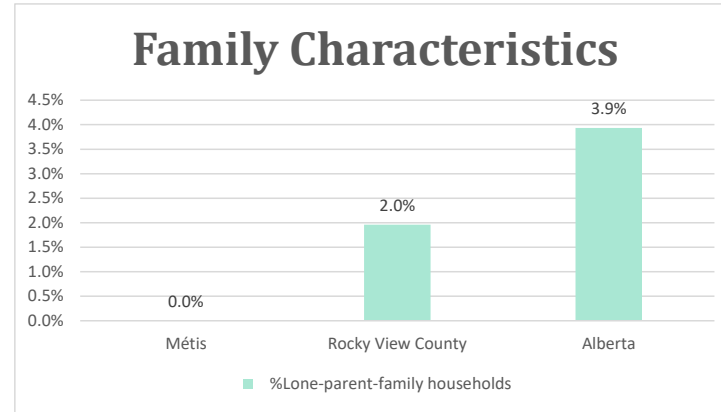

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 780 (Total Métis household is 340), representing 71% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 2.1% of the total population in Rocky View County.

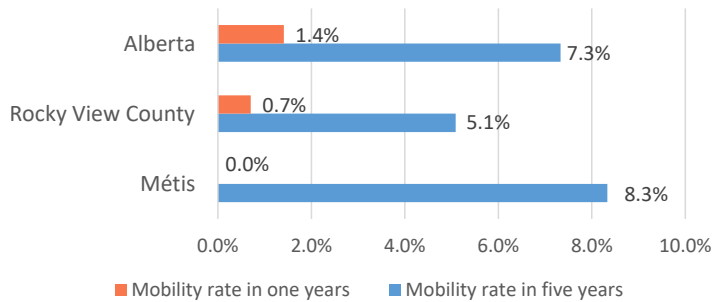


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 21.0 years old, with 64.7% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 42.5 in Rocky View County and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 80.2% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



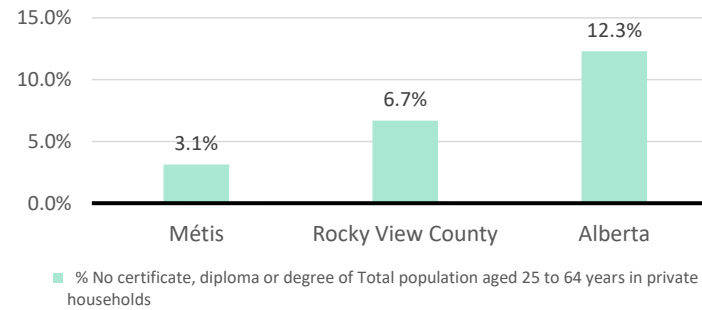
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

## Education



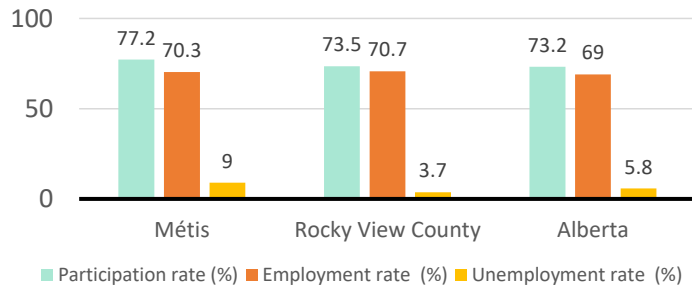
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 3.1% Métis compared to 6.7% in Rocky View County and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

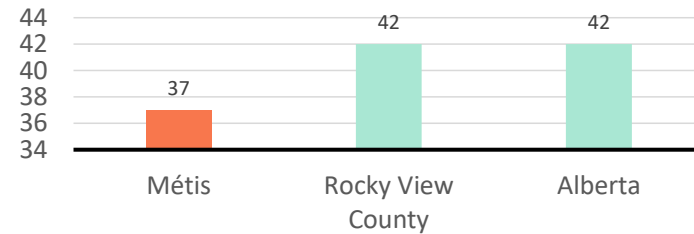
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 77.2%, employment rate is 70.3%, and unemployment rate is 9.0%.

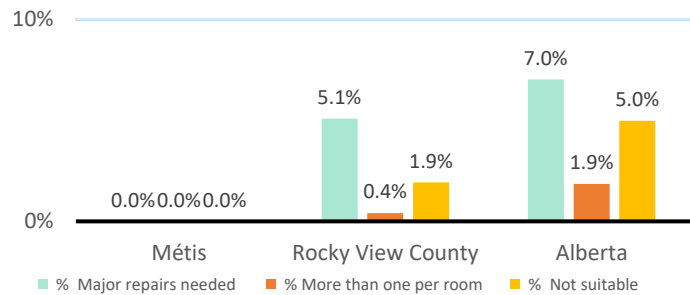
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Rocky View County and Alberta (73.5% and 73.2%), unemployment rate is also higher.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



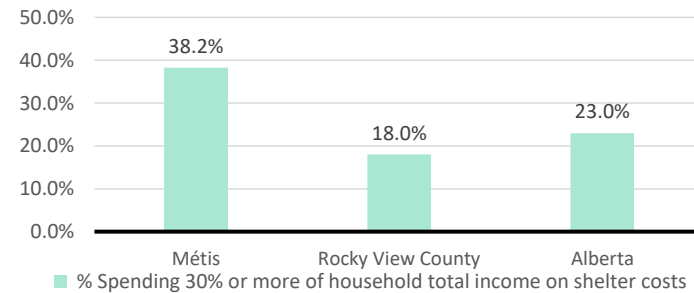
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 37.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 340 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which no Métis single household reported need major repairs, have more than one person per room, or not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



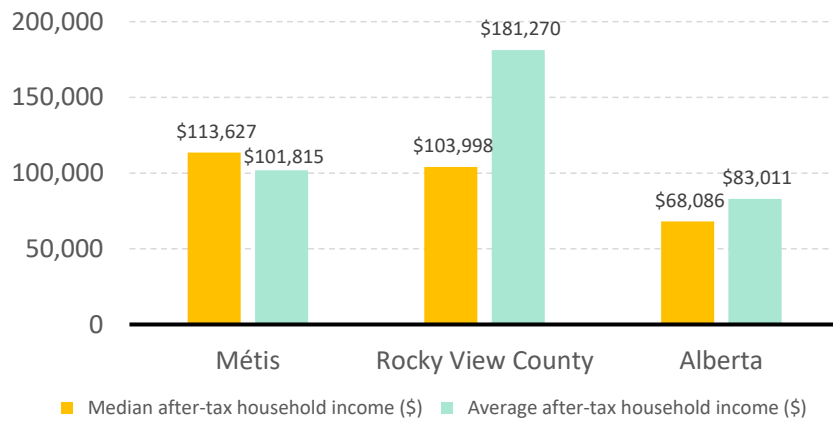
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 130, which is 38.2%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 18.0% of the total population in Rocky View County and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

## Income

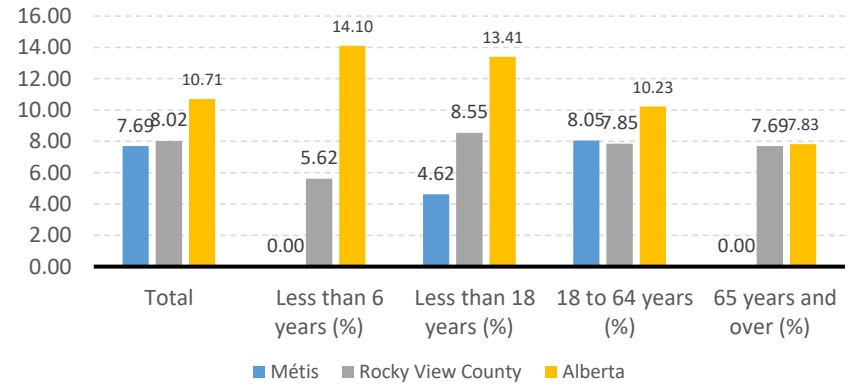
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$113,627, and average after-tax household income is

\$101,815. Métis has higher median and lower average after-tax income than Rocky View County, and higher median and average after-tax income than Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 7.69%.

The percentage of low income is 4.62% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 8.05% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
