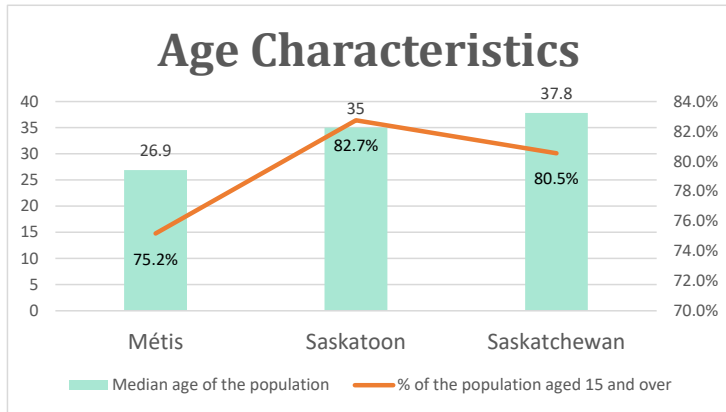

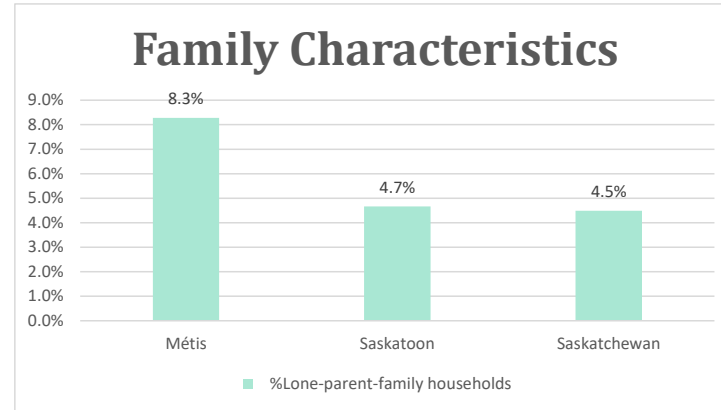

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 10,090 (Total Métis household is 5,720), representing 47% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 4.6% of the total population in Saskatoon.

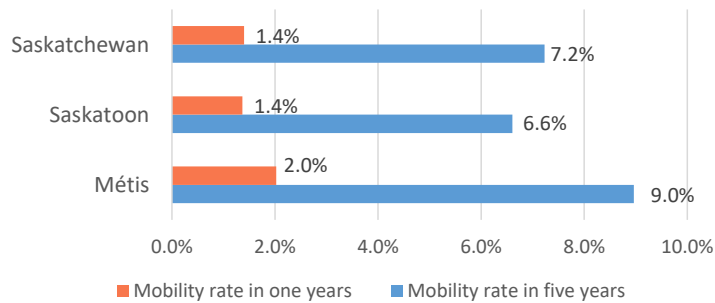


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 26.9 years old, with 75.2% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 35.0 in Saskatoon and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 82.7% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



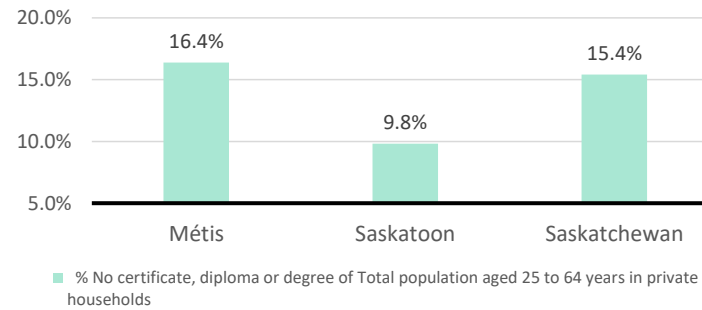
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 835, accounting for 8.3% of the total Métis single private households.

200 Métis households moved in last year (2.0%), 830 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (9.0%).

Education



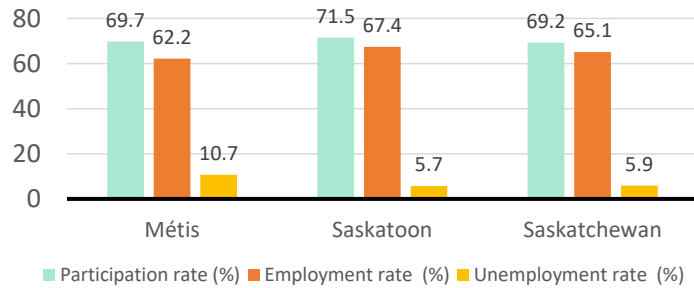
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 16.4% Métis compared to 9.8% in Saskatoon and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 11.9% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

Labor Force & Housing Statistics

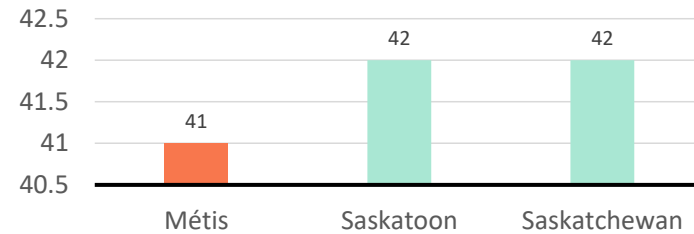
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 69.7%, employment rate is 62.2%, and unemployment rate is 10.7%.

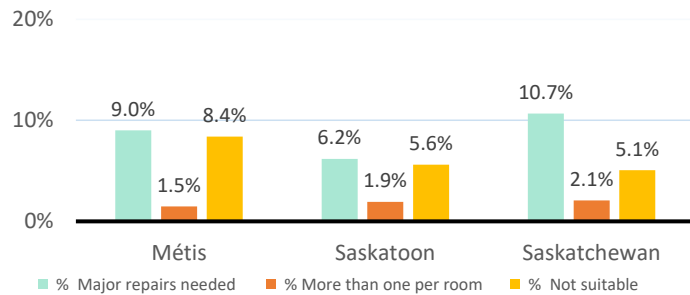
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Saskatoon and higher than Saskatchewan (71.5% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



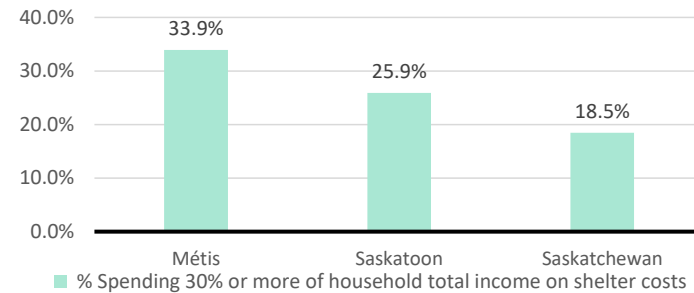
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 41.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 5720 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 9.0% need major repairs, 1.5% have more than one person per room, and 8.4% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



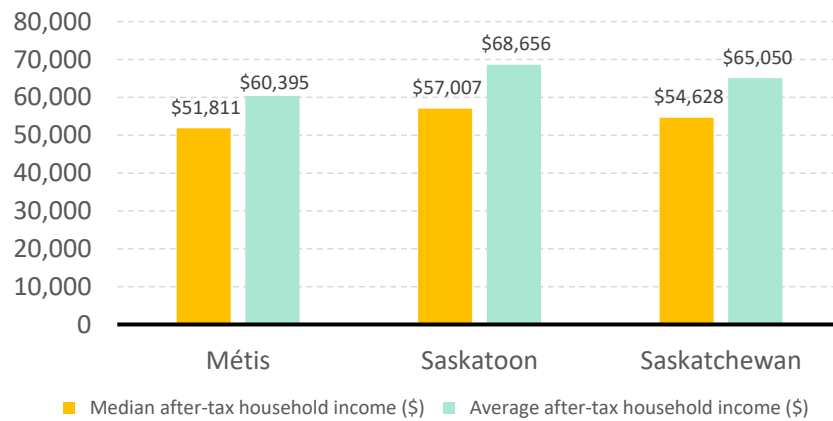
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 1940, which is 33.9%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 25.9% of the total population in Saskatoon and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

Income

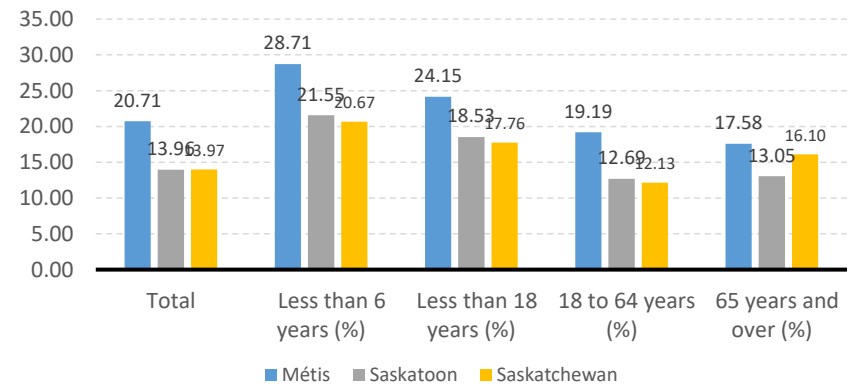
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$51,811, and average after-tax household income is

\$60,395. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Saskatoon and Saskatchewan.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 20.71%.

The percentage of low income is 24.15% for people less than 18 years old, 28.71% for people less than 6 years old, 19.19% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 17.58% for people over 65 years old.
