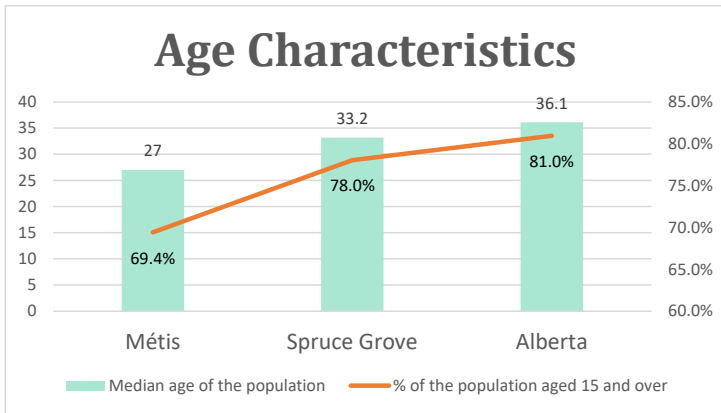

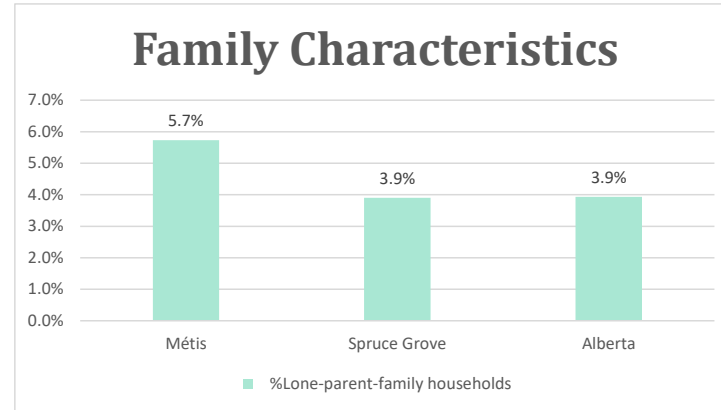

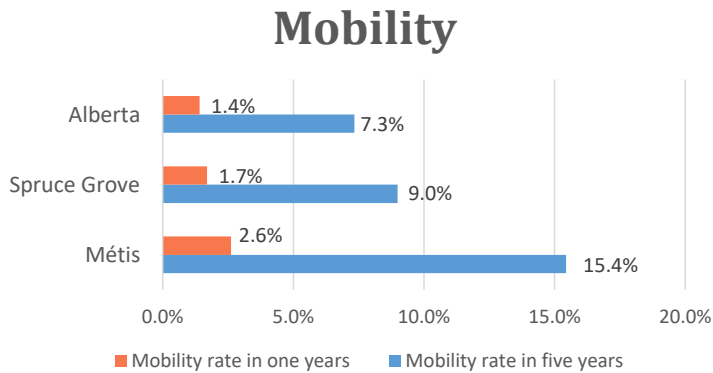
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 785 (Total Métis household is 460), representing 48% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.0% of the total population in Spruce Grove.



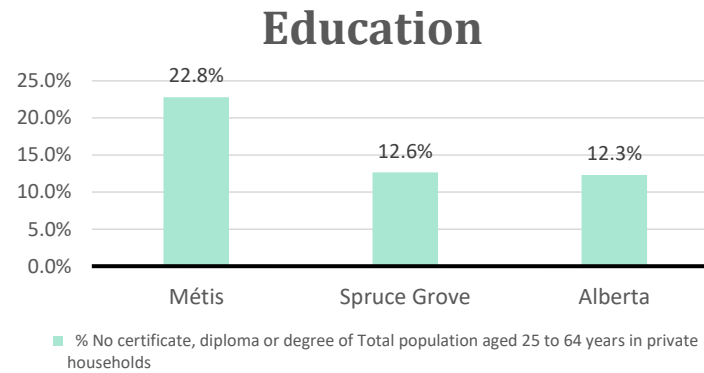
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 27.0 years old, with 69.4% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 33.2 in Spruce Grove and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 78.0% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



The number of Métis single lone parents household is 45, accounting for 5.7% of the total Métis single private households.



20 Métis households moved in last year (2.6%), 105 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (15.4%).



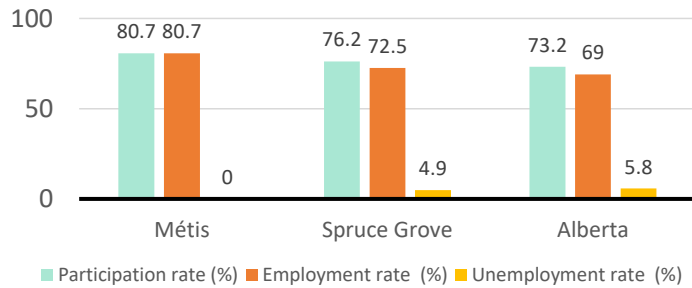
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 22.8% Métis compared to 12.6% in Spruce Grove and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

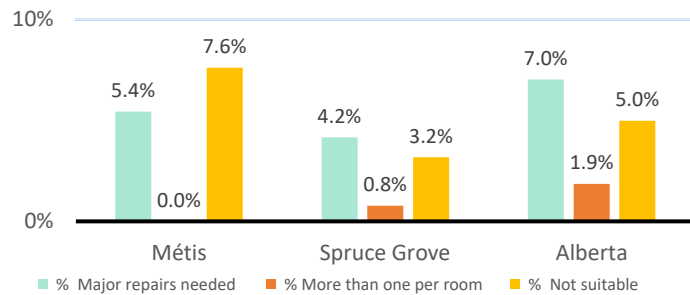
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 80.7%, employment rate is 80.7%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

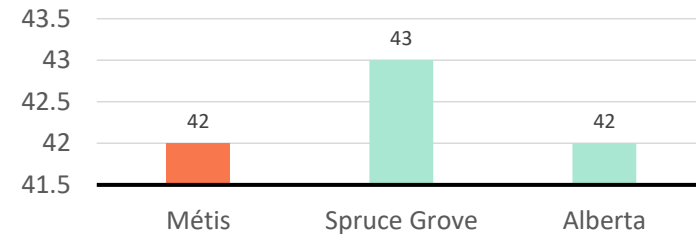
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Spruce Grove and Alberta (76.2% and 73.2%), no Métis reported unemployment.

Household Characteristics



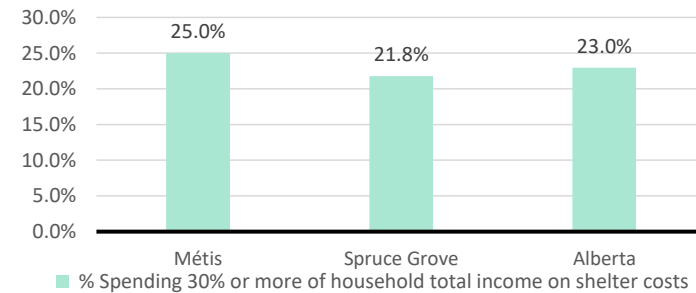
There are 460 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 5.4% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 7.6% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



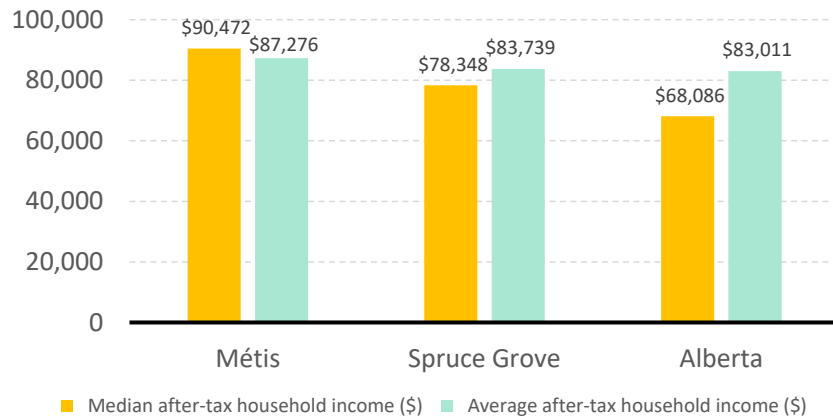
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 115, which is 25.0%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 21.8% of the total population in Spruce Grove and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

Income

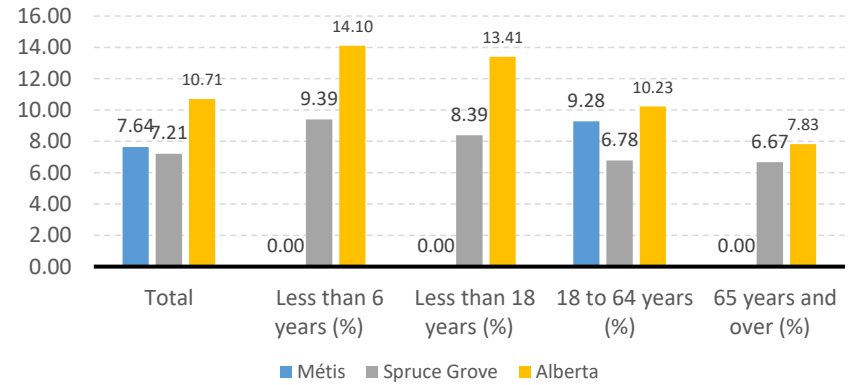
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$90,472, and average after-tax household income is

\$87,276. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Spruce Grove and Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 7.64%.

The percentage of low income is 9.28% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and no Métis household reported low income in other age groups.
