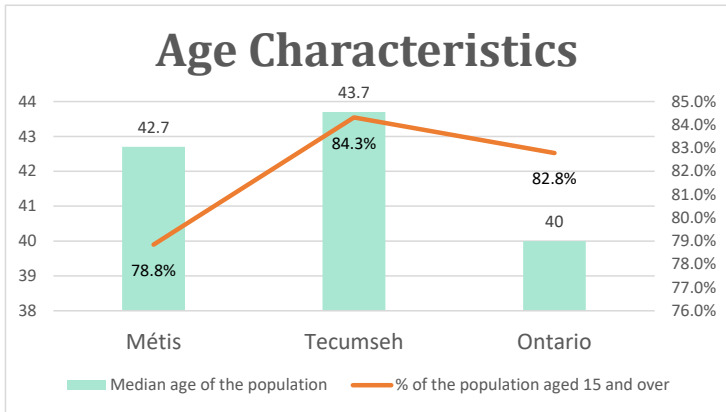


# Tecumseh, ON

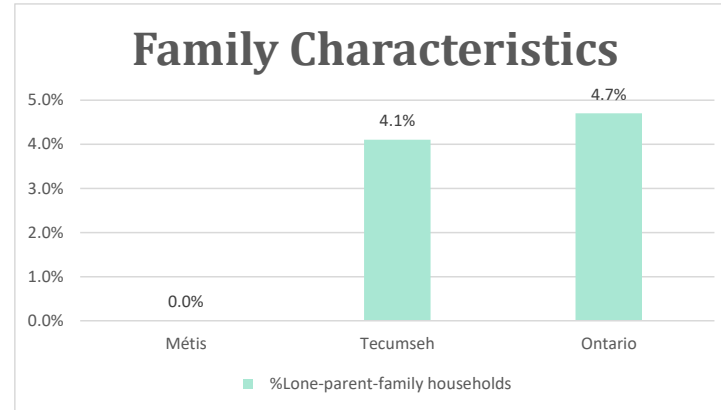

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 260 (Total Métis household is 140), representing 68% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 1.1% of the total population in Tecumseh.

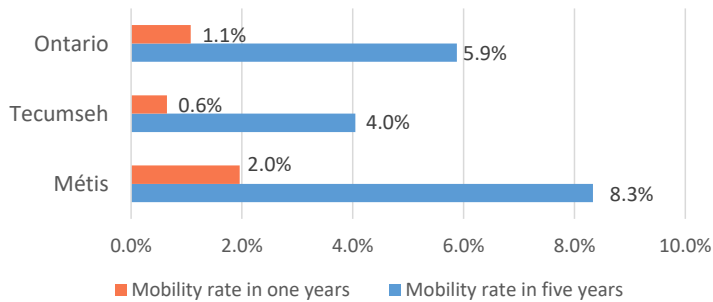


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 42.7 years old, with 78.8% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 43.7 in Tecumseh and 40.0 years old in Ontario, with 84.3% and 82.8% population aged 15 and over respectively.



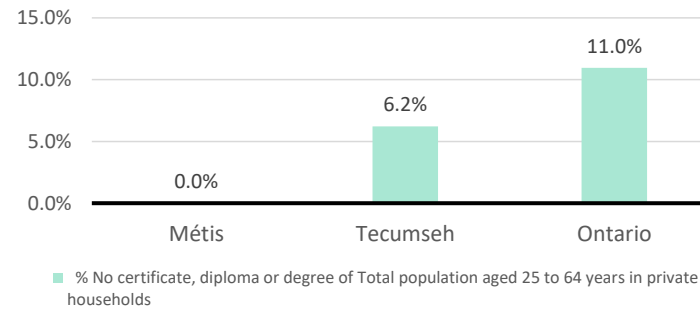
No Métis single lone parents household reported to the survey.

## Education



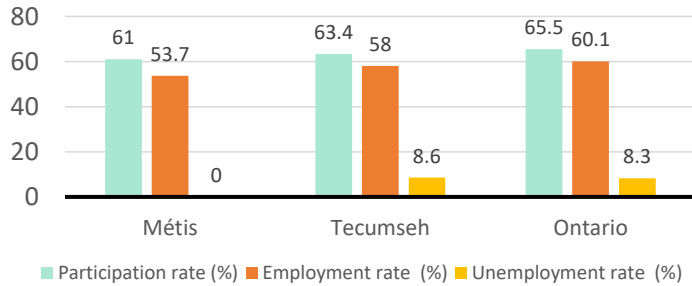
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, no Métis reported have no certificate, diploma or degree.

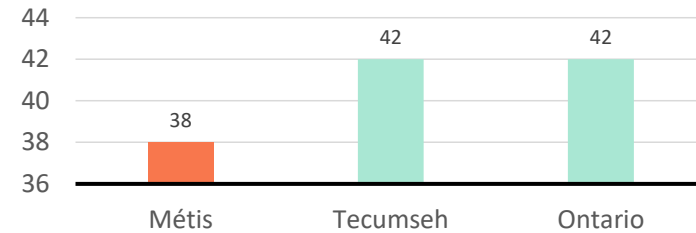
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 61.0%, employment rate is 53.7%, and unemployment rate is 0.0%.

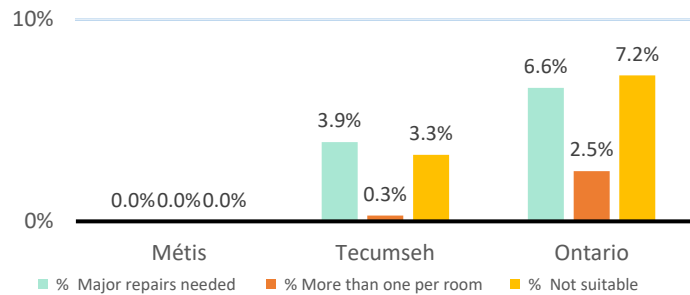
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Tecumseh and Ontario (63.4% and 65.5%), no Métis reported unemployment.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



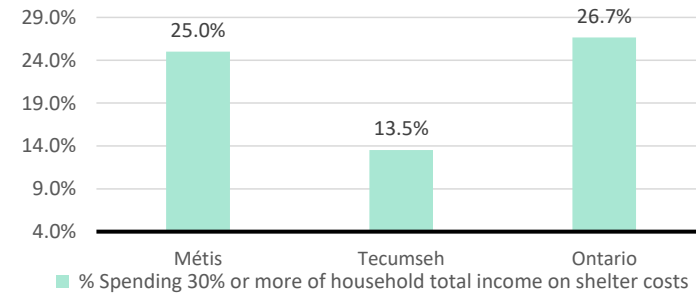
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 38.0 weeks.

### Shelter Costs



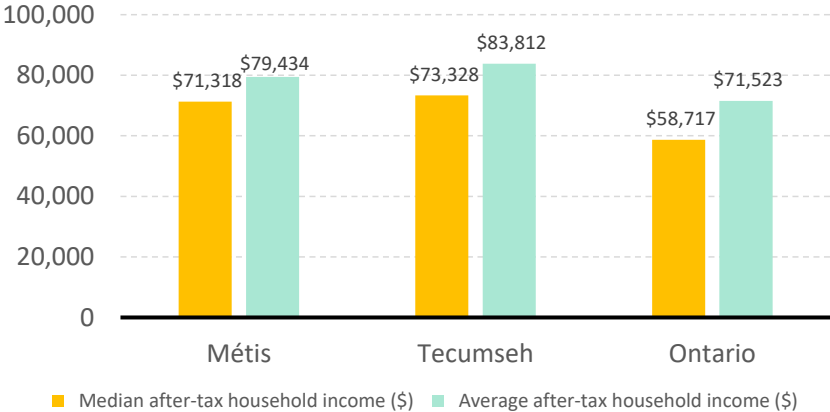
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 35, which is 25.0%

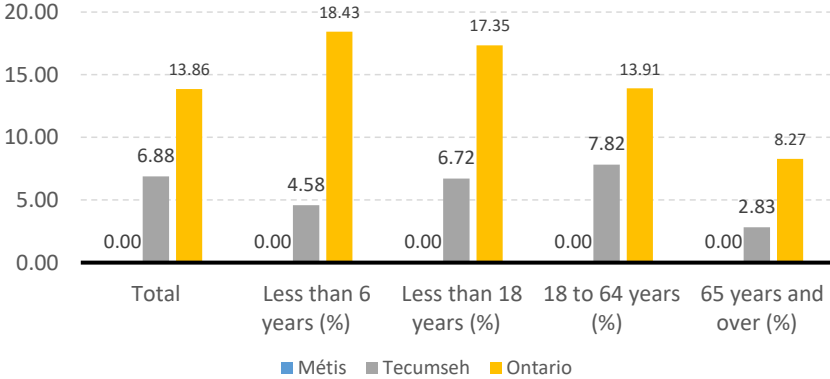
## Income

After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$71,318, and average after-tax household income is \$79,434. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Tecumseh, and higher median and average after-tax income than Ontario.
