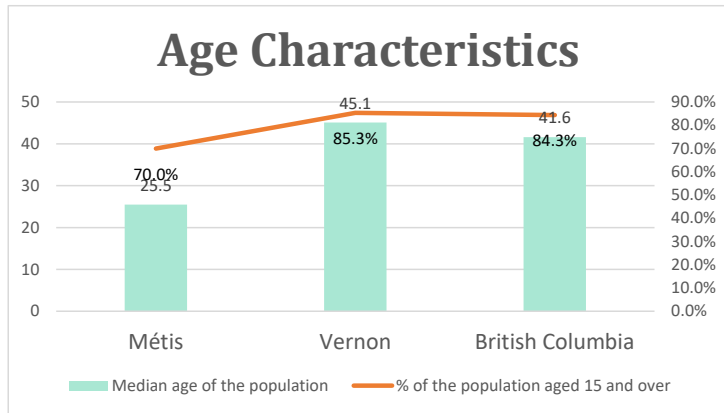

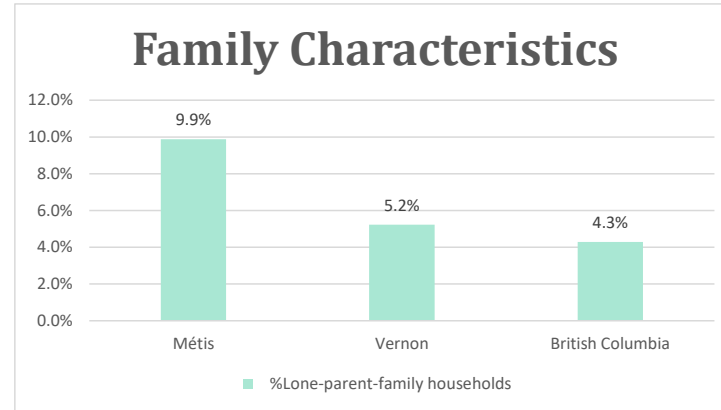

The total population reported with Métis single identity is 1,265 (Total Métis household is 675), representing 52% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.5% of the total population in Vernon.

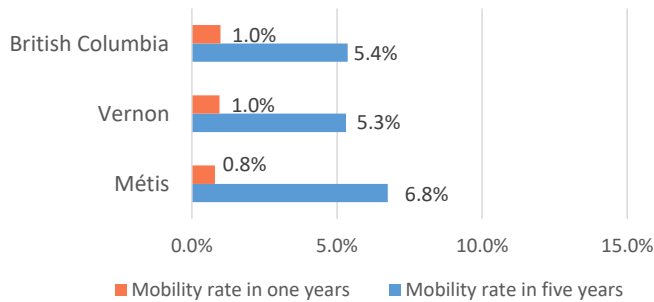


For Métis single identity population, the median age is 25.5 years old, with 70.0% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 45.1 in Vernon and 41.6 years old in British Columbia, with 85.3% and 84.3% population aged 15 and over respectively.



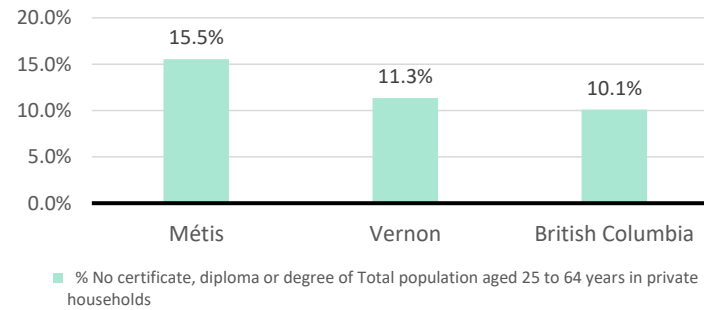
The number of Métis single lone parents household is 125, accounting for 9.9% of the total Métis single private households.

Education



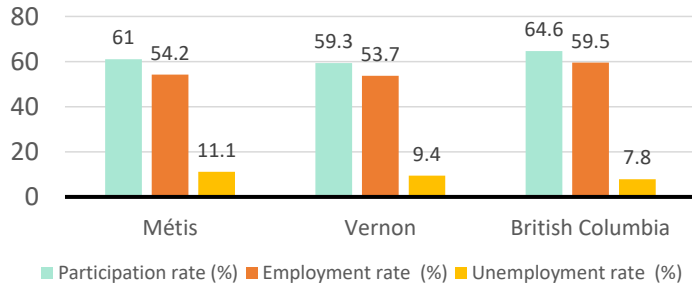
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 15.5% Métis compared to 11.3% in Vernon and 10.1% in British Columbia have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 20.0% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

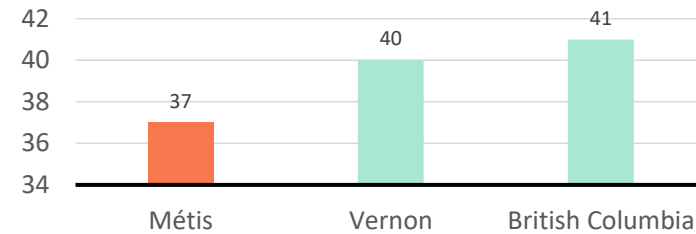
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 61.0%, employment rate is 54.2%, and unemployment rate is 11.1%.

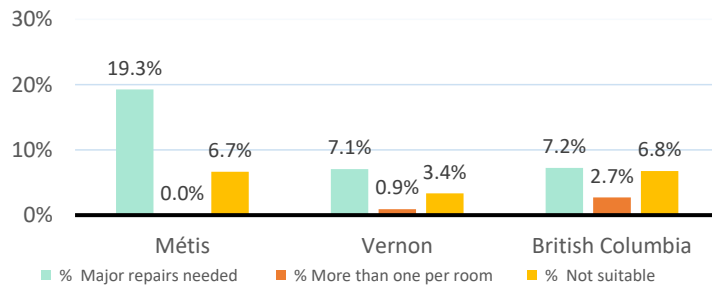
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Vernon and lower than British Columbia (59.3% and 64.6%), unemployment rate is higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



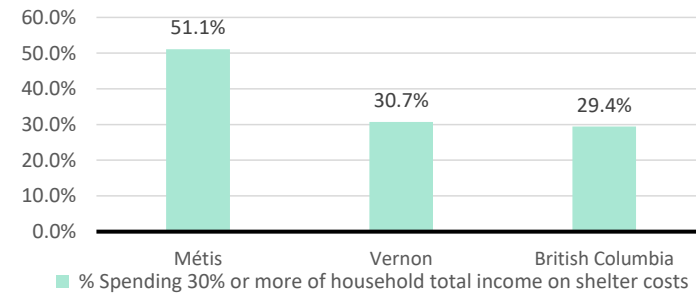
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 37.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 675 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 19.3% need major repairs, no Métis household reported have more than one person per room, and 6.7% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



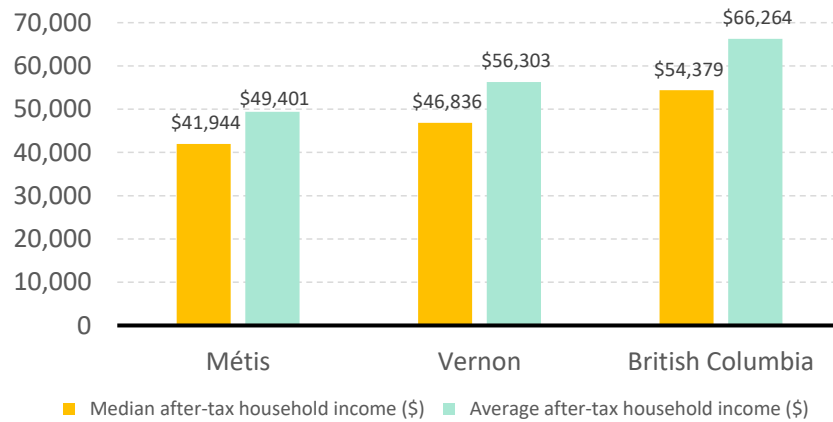
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 345,

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 30.7% of the total population in Vernon and 29.4% of the total population in British Columbia.

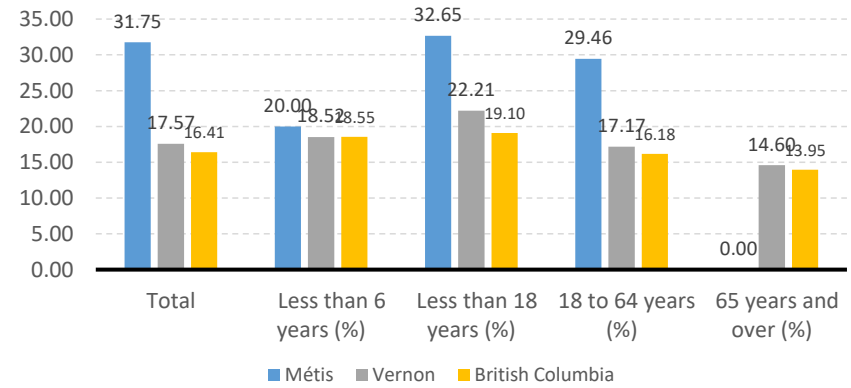
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$41,944, and average after-tax household income is

\$49,401. Métis has lower median and average after-tax income than Vernon and British Columbia.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 31.75%.

The percentage of low income is 32.65% for people less than 18 years old, 20.00% for people less than 6 years old, 29.46% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
