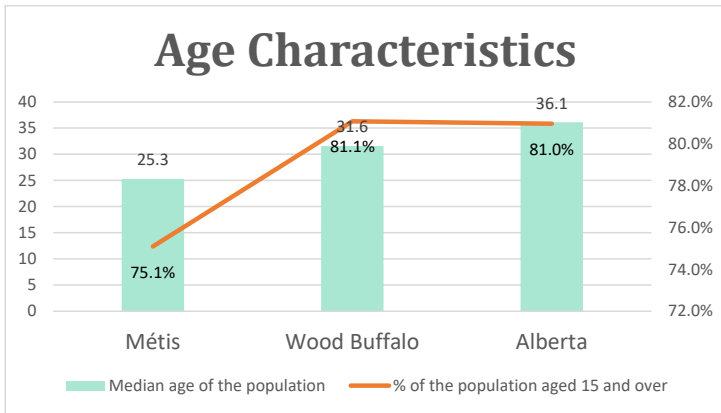


# Wood Buffalo, AB

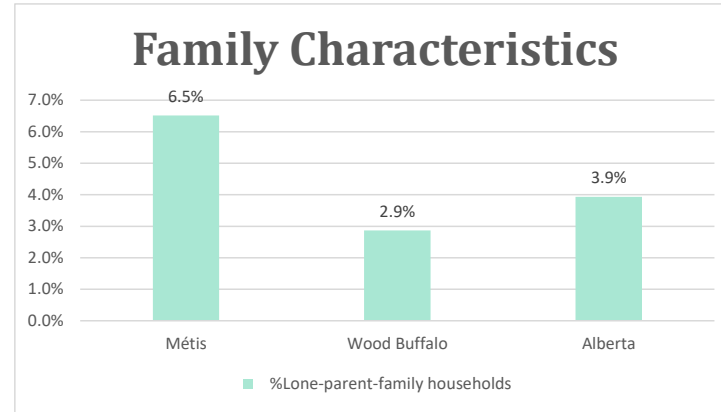

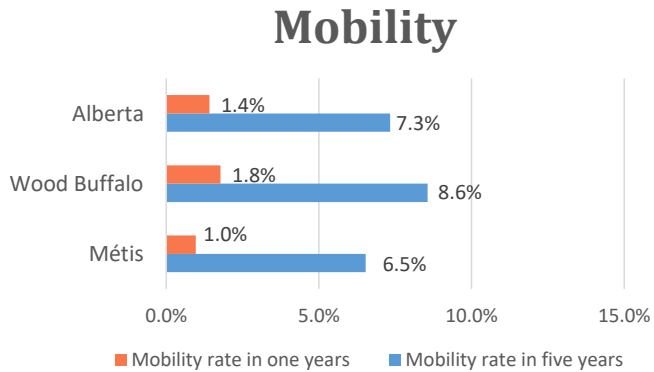
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 2,610 (Total Métis household is 1,390), representing 41% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 4.0% of the total population in Wood Buffalo.



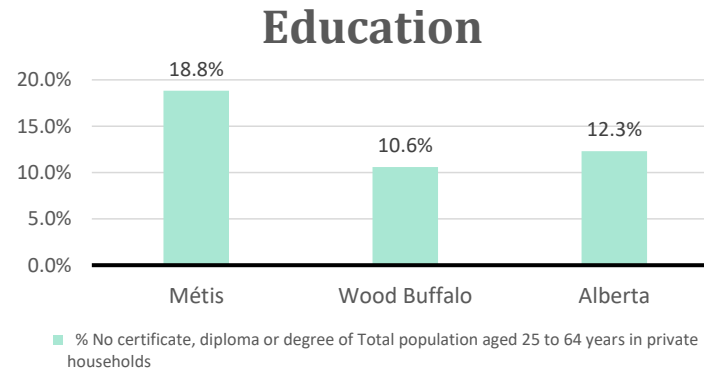
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 25.3 years old, with 75.1% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 31.6 in Wood Buffalo and 36.1 years old in Alberta, with 81.1% and 81.0% population aged 15 and over respectively.



The number of Métis single lone parents household is 170, accounting for 6.5% of the total Métis single private households.



25 Métis households moved in last year (1.0%), 160 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (6.5%).



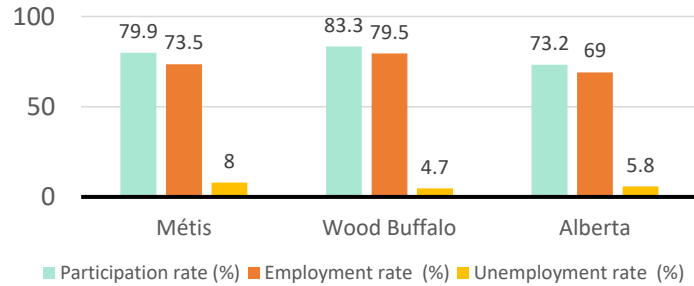
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 18.8% Métis compared to 10.6% in Wood Buffalo and 12.3% in Alberta have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 14.6% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

## Labor Force & Housing Statistics

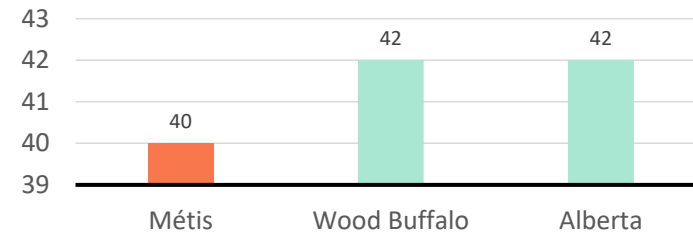
### Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 79.9%, employment rate is 73.5%, and unemployment rate is 8.0%.

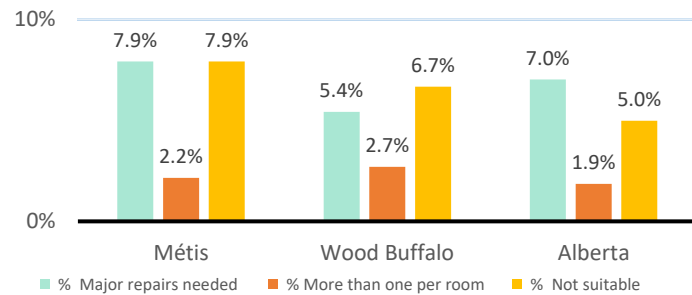
While the participation rate is lower compared with total population in Wood Buffalo and higher than Alberta (83.3% and 73.2%), unemployment rate is higher.

### Average Weeks Worked in 2010



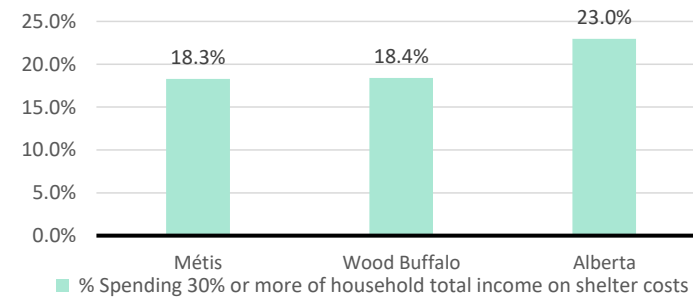
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 40.0 weeks.

### Household Characteristics



There are 1390 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 7.9% need major repairs, 2.2% have more than one person per room, and 7.9% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

### Shelter Costs



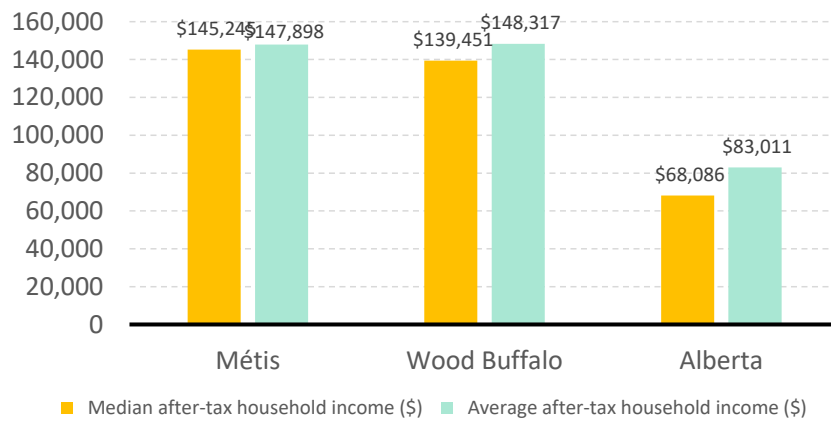
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 255, which is 18.3%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 18.4% of the total population in Wood Buffalo and 23.0% of the total population in Alberta.

## Income

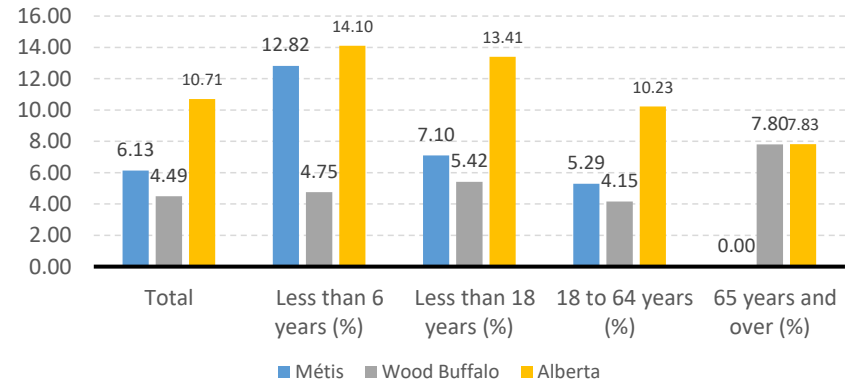
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$145,245, and average after-tax household income is

\$147,898. Métis has higher median and lower average after-tax income than Wood Buffalo, and higher median and average after-tax income than Alberta.

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 6.13%.

The percentage of low income is 7.10% for people less than 18 years old, 12.82% for people less than 6 years old, 5.29% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
