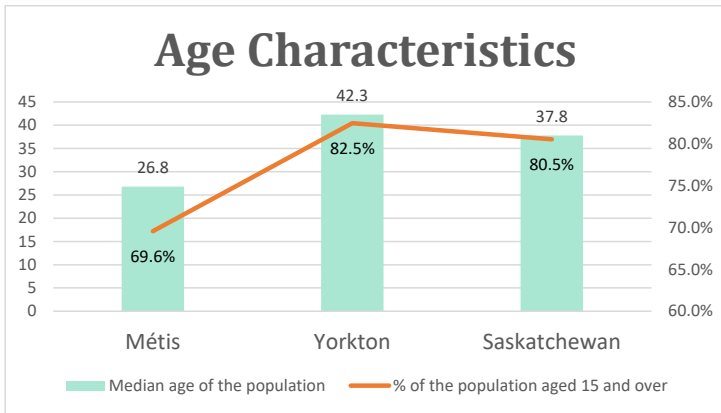

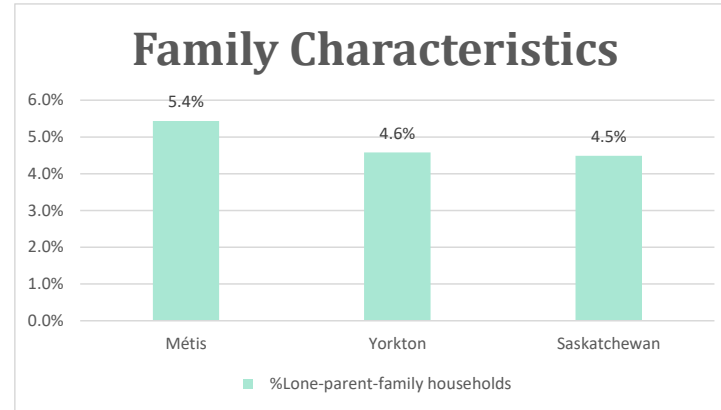

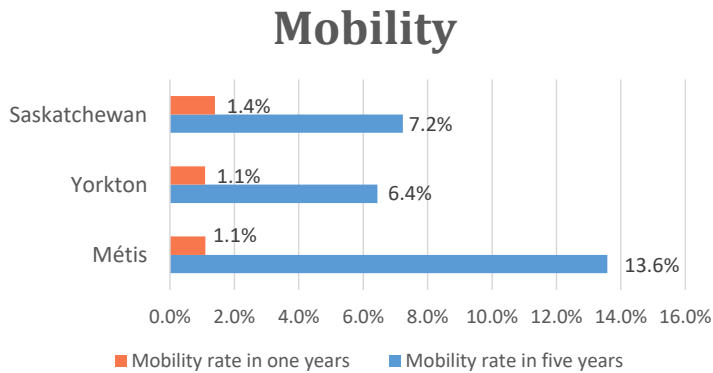
The total population reported with Métis single identity is 460 (Total Métis household is 265), representing 27% of Aboriginal people, accounting for 3.0% of the total population in Yorkton.



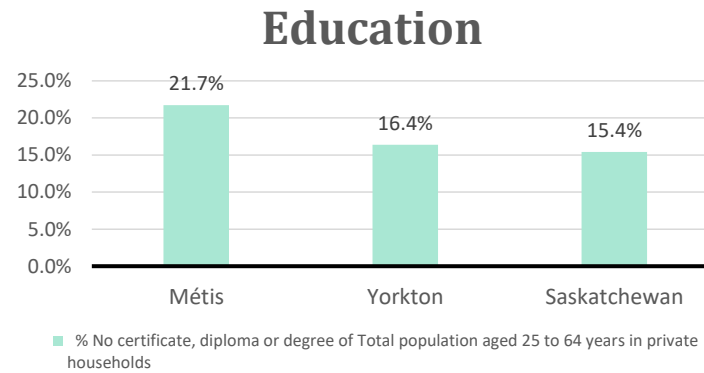
For Métis single identity population, the median age is 26.8 years old, with 69.6% of the population aged 15 and over. As for the total population, the median age is 42.3 in Yorkton and 37.8 years old in Saskatchewan, with 82.5% and 80.5% population aged 15 and over respectively.



The number of Métis single lone parents household is 25, accounting for 5.4% of the total Métis single private households.



5 Métis households moved in last year (1.1%), 55 Métis households moved in the past 5 years (13.6%).



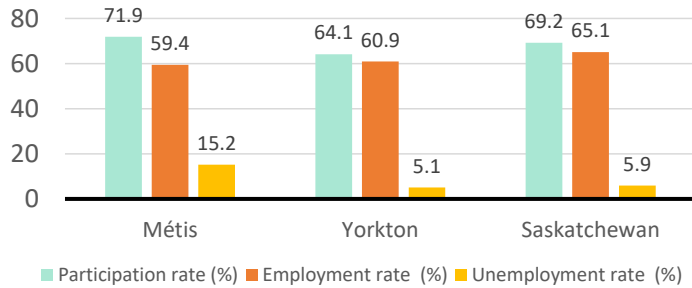
For population aged from 25 to 64 years, 21.7% Métis compared to 16.4% in Yorkton and 15.4% in Saskatchewan have no certificate, diploma or degree.

For Métis aged from 25 to 34, 33.3% Métis reported to have no certificate, diploma or degree.

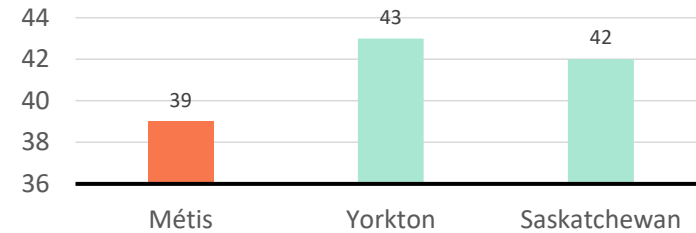
Labour Force Status



Métis participation rate is 71.9%, employment rate is 59.4%, and unemployment rate is 15.2%.

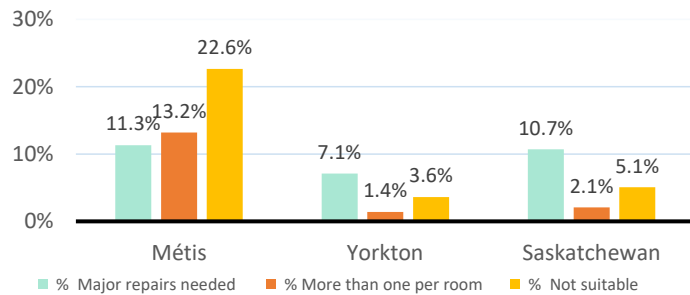
While the participation rate is higher compared with total population in Yorkton and Saskatchewan (64.1% and 69.2%), unemployment rate is also higher.

Average Weeks Worked in 2010



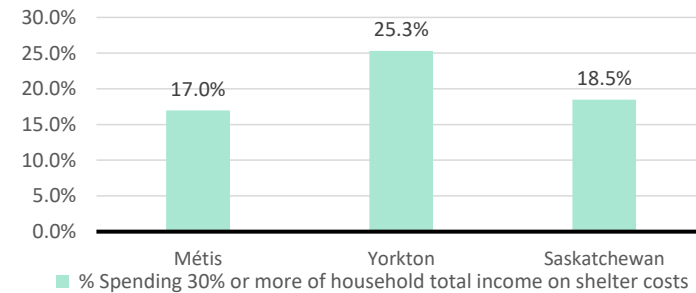
The average weeks worked in 2010 is 39.0 weeks.

Household Characteristics



There are 265 private dwellings occupied by a Métis single household, out of which 11.3% need major repairs, 13.2% have more than one person per room, and 22.6% Métis household reported to be not suitable.

Shelter Costs



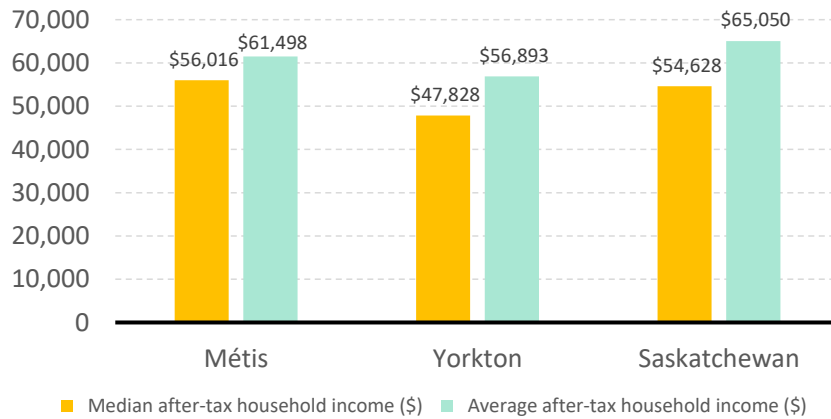
The number of Métis households spending 30% or more of household total income on shelter costs is 45, which is 17.0%

of the total private dwellings occupied by a Métis household, compared to 25.3% of the total population in Yorkton and 18.5% of the total population in Saskatchewan.

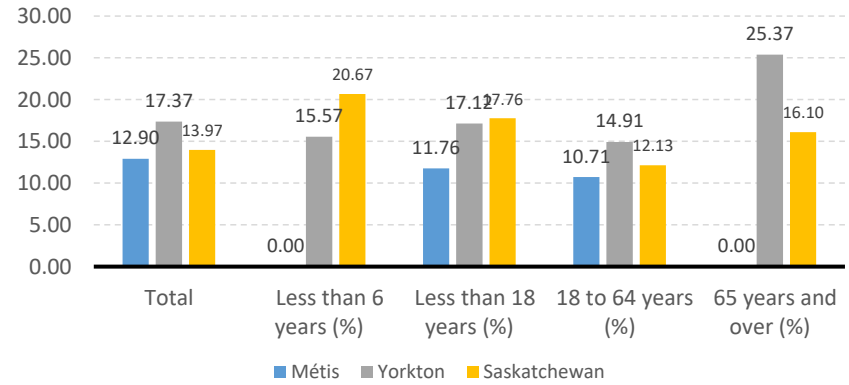
After-Tax Income of Households in 2010



For Métis singles, median after-tax household income is \$56,016, and average after-tax household income is

\$61,498. Métis has higher median and average after-tax income than Yorkton, and higher median and lower

Prevalence of Low Income in 2010 Based On After-Tax Low-Income Measure (%)



The prevalence of low income based on after-tax low-income measure is 12.90%.

The percentage of low income is 11.76% for people less than 18 years old, 0.00% for people less than 6 years old, 10.71% for people from 18 to 64 years old, and 0.00% for people over 65 years old.
